The undersigned, acting as incorporator(s) of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

Name

Florida Gulf Coast School of Theology & Seminary shall be operated in compliance with Section 246.083, Section 817.06 and Chapter 501, Florida Statutes, and with rule 6E-1.0031, Florida Administrative Code.

Florida Gulf Coast School of Theology & Seminary shall have its affairs conducted by a Board of Governors. The By-laws shall state the manner in which Board members shall be appointed.

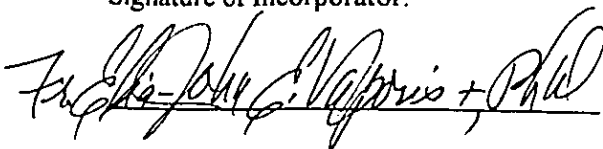

Pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned Florida nonprofit corporation adopts the following amendment(s) to its Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I. NAME: Florida Gulf Coast School of Theology & Seminary, Inc.

ARTICLE II. PRINCIPLE PLACE OF BUSINESS & MAILING ADDRESS

438 East Lemon Street, Tarpon Springs, Florida 34689

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE(S):

Addition to original, as follows: Florida Gulf Coast School of Theology & Seminary, Inc. is organized exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational purposes within the meaning of of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the CORRESPONDING PROVISION OF ANY FUTURE UNITED STATES INTERNAL REVENUE LAW.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization SHALL NOT CARRY ON ANY ACTIVITIES NOT PERMITTED TO BE CARRIED ON BY AN ORGANIZATION EXEMPT FROM FEDERAL INCOME TAX UNDER SECTION 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE IV. MANNER OF ELECTION OF OFFICERS:

The manner in which the Directors are elected or appointed is as follows: Florida Gulf Coast School of Theology & Seminary, Inc. shall have its affairs governed by a BOARD OF GOVERNORS. The by-laws shall state the manner in which members shall be appointed.

ARTICLE V. LIMITATIONS OF CORPORATE POWERS:

Addition to original, as follows: Upon the dissolution of this corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas (or its equivalent) of the county in which the principal office of this corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

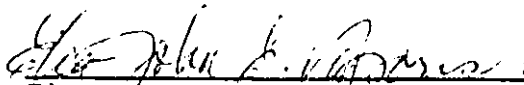
