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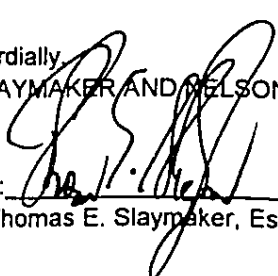

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION  
OF  
CITRUS COUNTY SEMINOLE CLUB, INC.

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FLA

The undersigned, for the purpose of forming a Florida Not-For-Profit Corporation, due hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is **CITRUS COUNTY SEMINOLE CLUB, INC.** and the mailing address of said Corporation is Post Office Box 3051, Inverness, Florida 34451-3051.

ARTICLE II

The term of existence of the Corporation is perpetual and the corporate existence will commence on the date of filing these Articles of Incorporation by the Department of State.

ARTICLE III

The Corporation may engage in any activity permitted under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes (1993), as such may be amended from time to time. The purposes for which this not-for-profit Corporation is organized include, but are not limited to, the following:

Devote and apply all property held by the Corporation and any income derived therefrom exclusively for charitable, cultural and educational purposes; either directly or by contributions to qualifying organizations duly authorized to carry on such activities. In pursuit of this purpose the Corporation will work to

- (1) Provide and generate financial, public opinion and community interest support for Florida State University;
- (2) Encourage prospective scholars to attend Florida State University;
- (3) Provide Citrus County and surrounding area residents an opportunity to participate in the affairs of Florida State University;
- (4) Provide advice on Citrus County and surrounding area needs and concerns to the University, the University's Alumni Association and the Seminole Boosters, Inc.; and
- (5) Promote and assist Florida State University, its Alumni Association, the Florida State University Foundation and the Seminole Boosters, Inc. in achieving their purposes and goals.

ARTICLE IV

The qualifications for members of the Corporation and the manner of their admission to membership shall be as regulated by the By Laws.

ARTICLE V

The Corporation shall not issue stock. No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to, any Director, Officer, member of the Corporation, or any private individual except that reasonable compensation may be paid for services rendered to or for the Corporation, and reasonable expenses may be paid thereto, affecting one or more of the Corporation's purposes. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not conduct or carry on any activities not permitted to be conducted or carried on by an organization exempt from taxation under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and Regulations issued pursuant thereto as they now exist, or as they may hereafter be amended, or by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under

Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code and the Regulations as they now exist or as they may hereafter be amended. On the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purposes of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed by a Court of competent jurisdiction in the county where the principal office of the Corporation is then located exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as the Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

#### ARTICLE VI

The street address of the initial registered office of the Corporation is 2218 Highway 44 West, Inverness, Florida 34453 and the name of the Corporation's initial registered agent is Thomas E. Slaymaker.

#### ARTICLE VII

The Corporation shall have three (3) directors initially. The method of election of the directors of the Corporation is set forth in the By Laws. The number of directors may be increased from time to time, as provided in the By Laws, but shall never be less than three (3). The names and street addresses of the initial directors are:

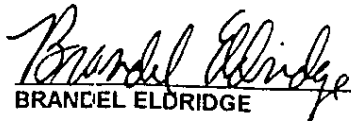

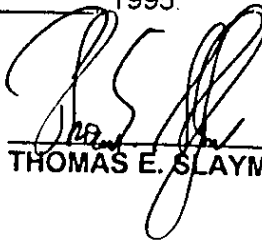
