SPIRIT OF THE SUWANNEE INDEPENDENT WINTER GUARD, INC.

BY THESE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION the incorporators form a corporation under Florida law

- 1. $\underline{\text{NAME}}$. The name of the corporation is SPIRIT OF THE SUWANNEE INDEPENDENT WINTER GUARD, INC.
- 2. <u>PURPOSE</u>. The purpose of which this corporation is organized is to teach commitment to Excellence through the Sport of the Arts; and to transact any and all lawful business for which corporations may be incorporated under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

3. MEMBERS.

- (a) The members of the corporation shall be those persons, including corporations, who have demonstrated an interest in the purposes of the corporation, and who pay membership dues.
- (b) Members of this corporation shall be admitted to membership by application to and approval by the Board of Directors of the corporation.
- (c) This corporation shall issue no stock. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this article. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation.

This corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, including the publishing or distribution of statements. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry or any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from kederal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law, or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law. On the dissolution of this corporation the board of directors shall dispose of all of the assets of this corporation exclusively for the purposes of this corporation in the manner or to the organization or organizations that are organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes and that shall at the time qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of this corporation. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county where the principal office of this corporation is then located exclusively for the purposes or to the organizations that the court determines are organized and operated exclusively for charitable, education, religious or scientific purposes.

- 4. TERM. This corporation shall exist perpetually.

6. OFFICERS.
