ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

We, the undersigned, with other persons, being desirous of forming a corporation for the purposes herein stated, under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, do agree to

ARTICLE I

ARTICLE VII OFFICERS

The affairs of the corporation shall be administered by the officers designated in the by laws. The officers shall be elected by the Board of Directors at its first meeting following the annual meeting of the members of the Association, and shall serve at the pleasure of the Board of Directors.
