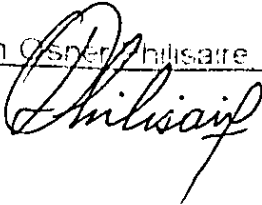

The Haitian community in Florida has faced many problems that need to be addressed. My first-hand experience with Broward school system allows me to understand that discrimination is one of the serious difficulties confronted by Haitians. I have learned to know my people during these years better than when I served them for twelve years as a teacher in the far back in Haiti. Having a clear understanding of the culture of a society is a prerequisite to fit in that society. That was one of the reasons I majored in social studies for my Master's Degree which was conferred last May. Most of the time, we have been told that we are ignoring what is far more important than the differences among cultures. Thus, their self-identity as a people has been lost and has become unsteady, and the result has been much social ill. The desire and the willingness to pay attention to this crisis are the basis for the creation of the "Haitian Youth for Educational and Cultural Awareness". This non-profit organization was organized to help the Haitian youth in Florida to understand the roots of the culture of their country and the future of their people, the need to educate the youth, the need to preserve the culture of the young generation of Haitian Americans.

In that spirit, we request the recognition of "Haitian Youth for Educational and Cultural Awareness" by the State of Florida. We request certification by the State of Florida as a non-profit organization for the limit of the law for the purpose of the organization.

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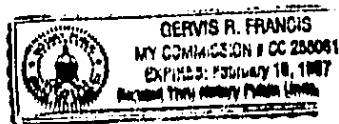

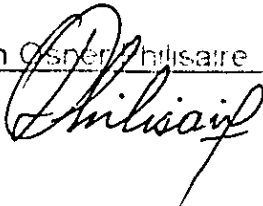
