ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF

BRANDON BAR ASSOCIATION, INC. A FLORIDA NONPROFIT CORPORATION



ARTICLE I

Name and Address

The name of the corporation is: Brandon Bar Association, Inc. The principal and registered office address of the corporation is 915 Oakfield Drive, Suite F, Brandon, Florida 33511.

ARTICLE 2

Duration

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE 3

THE PURPOSE FOR THE INCORPORATION

The Purposes of the Corporation are:

- 1. To nurture and promote the highest standards of professional conduct, proficiency in the legal arts and professional ethics among lawyers in the Greater Brandon area by providing an organization and a forum for fellowship and the exchange of ideas and information.
- 2. The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

3. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE 4

Members

The Corporation shall have Voting Members, who shall be elected (and may be removed) by the voting Members, and who shall have all the rights and privileges of members of the Corporation. The Bylaws may provide for Non-voting Members of one or more classes, who shall be admitted in such manner and who shall have such rights and privileges as are set forth in the Bylaws, but who shall not have the right to vote. Each officer shall be elected by the Board of Directors (and may be removed by the Board of Directors) at such time and in such manner as may be prescribed by the Bylaws. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas, of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes.
