ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT TO THE ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION FOR The House of Refuge, Inc.

Pursuant to the provisions of Florida Non-Profit Corporation Act, the undersigned corporation adopts the following Article of Amendment to its Articles of Incorporation which: The corporation has no members. The following amendments to the Articles of Incorporation was adopted by the corporation board of directors on July 13, 1997, at 204 Essex Drive, Fort Pierce, Florida 34946.

The Articles of Incorporation, are hereby amended so as to read as follows: Said Corporation/organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations under section 50l (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or the corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of Section 50l(c)(3) purposes. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to any candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 50l(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code) o (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code (or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code).

Upon the dissolution of this corporation/organization assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal government or to a state or local government for a public purpose/
