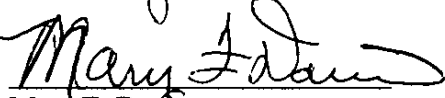

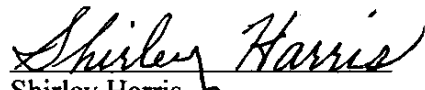

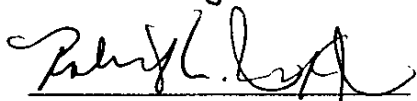

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**AMENDED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION**

**FOR**

**GREATER NEW HOPE AFRICAN METHODIST EPISCOPAL  
CHURCH OF JACKSONVILLE, INC.**

ARTICLE ONE

The name of the corporation shall be:  
Greater New Hope African Methodist Episcopal Church of Jacksonville, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO

The principal place of business for this corporation shall be:  
2708 Davis Street  
Jacksonville, FL 32209

ARTICLE THREE

The purpose for which the corporation is organized is:

The general purpose of this corporation is to foster and encourage religious worship in accordance with the principles of the African Methodist Episcopal Church; that it shall purchase, take, receive, lease take by gift, devise or bequest or otherwise acquire, own, hold, improve, use, or otherwise deal in and with real or personal property or any interest therein wherever situated, in trust, for the use and benefit of the African Methodist Episcopal Church. It shall have the right to make conveyance of its property in accordance with the rules of the general body of the African Methodist Episcopal Church and the current edition of "The Doctrine and Discipline of the African Methodist Episcopal Church"; it being understood that said corporation shall not be required to accept any donations or gifts not in harmony with the purpose and object of said corporation. Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

ARTICLE FOUR

The term of existence of the corporation is as follows:

The corporation shall have perpetual existence, unless it becomes in conflict with the laws of the African Methodist Episcopal Church as found in the current edition of "The Doctrine and Discipline of the African Methodist Episcopal Church" and is dissolved in the manner provided by law. In the event of dissolution of the corporation and after the payments of all debts and monies or assets remaining shall not inure to benefit of any individual but shall be held in trust by the East Annual Conference of the African Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc. Additionally, assets shall be distributed to the Federal Government or to a State or Local Government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principle office of the organization is then located, exclusively

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for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

ARTICLE FIVE

The manner in which the Board of Trustees and the Directors shall be appointed is as follows:

The Board of Trustees and Directors shall be appointed in accordance with the current edition of "The Doctrine and Discipline of the African Methodist Episcopal Church".

ARTICLE SIX

The Bylaws that will govern the corporation are as follows:

The Bylaws that will govern this corporation are the laws as are encroached in, "The Doctrine and Discipline of the "African Methodist Episcopal Church" and such amendments to said book as is revised and compiled by the General Conference of the African Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc. periodically and thereafter.

No substantial part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation and the organization shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on: (a) by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (c) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future Federal Tax Code.

ARTICLE SEVEN

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes, unless limited as follows:

The powers and responsibilities of the corporation are limited by the rules and regulations of the African Methodist Episcopal Church, Inc. and the current edition of "The Doctrine and Discipline of the African Methodist Episcopal Church".

ARTICLE EIGHT

Earnings of this incorporation shall be governed accordingly:

No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purpose set forth in the purpose clause hereof.
