This letter is written in reference to Document # N95000006014 FEI # 59-3352812 regarding Gravely Woods Owners Association, Incorporation. As the new 2006 appointed president of the association I am enclosing a check for \$306.25 for reinstatement (\$175.00) certificate of status (\$8.75) along with (\$122.50) annual report fees for the years 2002, 06. I am requesting a waiver of fees for 2003, 04 and 05 years for the following reasons.

- In 2002 a new president was appointed but unfortunately annual forms were not filed therefore causing the association to be administratively dissolved in October 2004 by your offices.
- 2) Members/Residents were unaware of the situation, the legality, paperwork issues and at loss to better their community. As the residents were uncertain how to begin the process the association just floundered.
- Myself and other new residents to the community began to question our neighbors regarding the horrific conditions of our roads and thus began to hold meetings.
