To Whom It May Concern;

This letter is written in reference to Document # N95000006014 FEI # 59-3352812 regarding Gravely Woods Owners Association, Incorporation. As the new 2006 appointed president of the association I am enclosing a check for \$306.25 for reinstatement (\$175.00) certificate of status (\$8.75) along with (\$122.50) annual report fees for the years 2002, 06. I am requesting a waiver of fees for 2003, 04 and 05 years for the following reasons.

- 1) In 2002 a new president was appointed but unfortunately annual forms were not filed therefore causing the association to be administratively dissolved in October 2004 by your offices.
- 2) Members/Residents were unaware of the situation, the legality, paperwork issues and at loss to better their community. As the residents were uncertain how to begin the process the association just floundered.
- 3) Myself and other new residents to the community began to question our neighbors regarding the horrific conditions of our roads and thus began to hold meetings.
- 4) I was able to recover records for the association only to encounter that nothing had be done appropriately for the 2002, 03, 04 and 05 years. I found no new uniform business annual report forms (UBR) in the files nor filed with your department. We have no idea were the papers were mailed or what happened to them so to further avoid this problem in the future we have opened a post office box solely for association. Also other officers have been given respected duties to carry out and have informed all residents of the association's mailings.

For the above aforementioned reasons we ask that the 2003, 2004 and 2005 years of dissolution to be waived as we are a small community just beginning to collect dues and having to pay the entire fees would overwhelm us and inhibit our ability to move forward and fix our roads to a reasonable driving condition.
