TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA We the undersigned, being of legal age and natural persons, do hereby subscribed to acknowledge and file the following Articles of Incorporation to form a not-for-profit corporation for charitable purposes under the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation shall be: Sparkman Foundation, Inc. (the "Corporation") and the principal place of business for the Corporation shall be in Lake Panasoffkee, Sumter County, Florida.

ARTICLE II. OBJECT AND PURPOSE

The purposes for which this Corporation are formed are:

- (a) To enter into, make, and perform contracts and agreements; to purchase or otherwise acquire, hold, lease, encumber, sell, assign, transfer, mortgage, pledge, exchange or otherwise dispose of any real, personal, or intangible personal property in the same manner and to the same extent as a natural person might do exclusively for the enhancement, benefit and in furtherance of the charitable purposes allowable under the Internal Revenue Code, including exclusively charitable, literary, scientific and educational purposes.
- (b) To carry on or engage in any activity which the Corporation may deem proper or convenient in connection with the purposes hereinabove stated and to use any and all of its assets from whatever source obtained, either the principal or income therefrom, either immediately or in the future, for the furtherance of the corporate purposes and objects.
- (c) All assets and earning of this Corporation shall be used exclusively for the purposes hereinabove stated including the payment of expenses incident thereto, and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private person, entity or individual.
- (d) In the event of dissolution of this Corporation, all the remaining assets of the Corporation shall be distributed to the organizations exempt from taxation or public entities exempt from taxation under the Internal Revenue Code.
- (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code as it now

exists or as amended in the future.

ARTICLE III. MEMBERSHIP

Qualification of membership shall be as set forth in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE IV. TERM OF EXISTENCE

The term for which this Corporation shall exist shall be perpetual.



(j) The corporation will not make any taxable expenditures as defined in section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding provisions of any later federal tax laws.



FIRST: Amendment adopted:

ARTICLE II. OBJECT AND PURPOSE, Paragraph D is amended to read as follows:

(d) Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court for Sumter County, Florida, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

SECOND: The date of adoption of the amendment was November 5, 1996.
