ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

NATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF COLLEGE ATHLETES, INC. TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

Article I.  
Name

The name of the Corporation shall be National Association of College Athletes, Inc.

Article II.  
Principle place of business and mailing address

The principle place of business of this Corporation shall be 405 Dunwoody Street #9, Tallahassee, Florida 32304, and mailing address will be P.O. Box 2411, Tallahassee, Florida, 32316.

Article III.  
Purpose(s)

Said corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article IV.  
Manner of Election of directors

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed shall be stated in the Bylaws.

Article V.  
Limitation of corporate powers

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation [or organization] shall be empowered to make the election authorized under section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986. The corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or

distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a corporations contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

Article VI.  
Dissolution and Liquidation

In the event of dissolution or final liquidation of the corporation, the board of directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all lawful debts and liabilities of the corporation, distribute all the assets of the corporation to one or more of the following categories of recipients as the board of directors of the corporation shall determine:

(a) a nonprofit organization or organizations having similar aims and objectives as the corporation and which may be selected as an appropriate recipient of such assets, as long as such organization or each such organizations shall then qualify as a governmental unit under section 170(c) of the Internal revenue Code of 1986 or as an organization exempt from federal income taxation under section 501(a) of such Code as an organization described in section 501(c)(3) of such Code.
