We, the undersigned, acting as incorporators pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME AND PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS

The name of this corporation shall be the Seminole County Sheriff's Office Citizen Police Academy Alumni Association, Inc., and its principal place of business shall be at 1345 28th Street, Sanford, Seminole County, Florida 32773.

ARTICLE II

PURPOSE AND OBJECTIVES

The purpose of this corporation not for profit, shall be to support the Seminole County Sheriff's Office and promote and improve relationships between citizens and law enforcement agencies within Seminole County; and to (a) Serve as the Seminole County Sheriff's Office ambassadors to the community to increase public awareness of the Sheriff's Office, (b) Foster effective working relationships of trust and respect to improve police/community relations, (c) Promote activities and programs which increase community awareness of the Sheriff's office, and (d) Use, to the greatest extent possible, existing resources and infrastructures to pursue the foregoing objectives and purposes.

ARTICLE III

MEMBERSHIP

Individuals who successfully complete the Seminole County Sheriff's Office Citizen Police Academy and uphold the ideals of good citizenship and regular or reserve law enforcement officers may become a member of this corporation not for profit.

ARTICLE IV

BY-LAWS

By-Laws of this corporation may be adopted, amended, altered, or rescinded by an affirmative vote of not less than fifty-one (51) percent of the General Membership present and voting at a duly constituted meeting, provided written notice of the proposed action has been provided to the members not less than two weeks prior thereto.

ARTICLE V

AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The Articles of Incorporation may be amended by an affirmative vote of not less than fifty-one (51) percent of the General Membership present and voting at a duly constituted meeting, provided written notice of the proposed action has been provided to the members not less than two weeks prior thereto.

ARTICLE VI

ELECTIONS

The initial officers and board of directors shall serve until their successors are elected and have qualified, or until their resignation or removal. Thereafter, officers and directors shall be elected in such numbers and terms of office as established in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VII

LIMITATION OF CORPORATE POWERS

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in Section 617.0302, Florida Statutes.

The following amendments are to be added or deleted as specified to the existing Articles of Incorporation for The aforementioned corporation pursuant to the provisions of section 617.1006, Florida Statutes. The undersigned officer of said corporation also acknowledges that the following articles of amendment will be attached to the form submitted by the Florida Secretary of State for this purpose and will become one.

First: Amendment adopted ; This amendment replaces the original article V.

ARTICLE V AMENDMENTS TO ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION

The Article of Incorporation may be amended by an affirmative vote of not less than fifty-one (51) percent of the sitting Board of Directors present and voting at a duly constituted meeting, provided written notice of the proposed action has been provided to the board not less then ten (10) days prior thereto.

Second: amendment added;

ARTICLE X EXEMPTION

a. Said organization is organized exclusively for charitable, religious and educational purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

b. No part of the net earnings of the organization shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the organization shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in the purpose clause hereof. No substantial

part of the activities of the organization shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the organization shall not



participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of this document, the organization shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by an organization exempt from federal income tax under section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by an organization, contributions to which are deductible under section 170 (C) (2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

c. Upon the dissolution of said corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more of the exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501 (C) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the court of common pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
