and is operational under the by-laws of Standing in the Gaps.

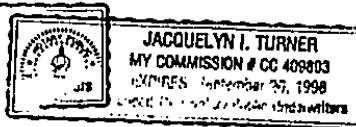
Since October, 1994 and to this present time as well as

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
FAMILY RESTORATION MINISTRIES, INC.

BY THESE ARTICLE OF INCORPORATION the incorporators form a corporation under Florida law.

1. NAME. The name of the corporation is FAMILY RESTORATION MINISTRIES, INC.

2. TERM. This corporation shall exist perpetually.

3. PURPOSES.

(a) The purpose for which this corporation is organized is to facilitate family healing thru religious and educational seminars, courses, books, videos, and materials.

(b) This corporation shall issue no stock. No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in this article. No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation. This corporation shall not participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office, including the publishing or distribution of statements. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States internal revenue law, or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal revenue law. On the dissolution of this corporation the board of directors shall dispose of all of the assets of this corporation exclusively for the purposes of this corporation in the manner or to the organization or organizations that are organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes and that shall at the time qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal revenue law, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all liabilities of this corporation. Any assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county where the principal office of this corporation is then located

exclusively for the purposes of the organizations that the court determines are organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious or scientific purposes.

4. DIRECTORS. The qualifications for and manner of admission of such shall be regulated by the bylaws.

5. REGISTERED OFFICE. The initial/registered office of the corporation is 660 W. Fairbanks Avenue, Winter Park, FL 32789, and its initial registered agent is Jacquelyn I. Turner.

6. DIRECTORS. The corporation shall have 3 directors initially. The number of directors may be changed from time to time in the bylaws. The name and address of each person who is to serve as an initial director is:


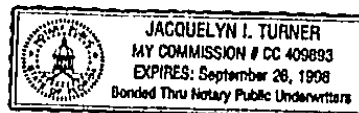


