ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pusuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

PREAMBLE

This Club was organized in 1969 through the efforts of many in the cities of Niceville and Valparaiso. A Senior Citizens group began meeting in 1965 as the result of efforts by Mrs. Hobart Mayo of Niceville. The group met from April through October of that year, until interest waned. Mrs. Mayo's determination led to renewed interest in the idea in April of 1969. Finally, an organizing committee was elected in October of 1969 to make final plans to establish the club. The committee was comprised of: Dr. Fanny-Fern Davis (Mrs. Everett F.), President: Mary Belle Cuchens (Mrs. Eugene), Secretary: and Julia Mayo (Mrs. Hobart), Program Chairman, to work with area churches to provide programs and refreshments for the monthly meetings of the senior citizens until such time as the organization became self-sustaining. The Twin Cities Senior Citizens Club held its first formal meeting in the Mitchell Building in Valparaiso in November 1969. In February 1970, the Club moved into its present quarters in the Valparaiso Community Building on Glenview Avenue. The officers of the Club, recognizing the desire of its members to continue the organization, are complying with the State of Florida laws to register as a not for profit charitable corporation.

ARTICLE I
