ARTICLE I. NAME

The name of this corporation is RAD MINISTRIES, INC.

ARTICLE II. DURATION AND COMMENCEMENT

The duration of the corporation shall be perpetual. The corporate existence shall commence upon filing of these Articles.

ARTICLE III. PURPOSE

This corporation is not-for-profit and is organized for the purpose of evangelizing those who do not know Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior and educating and edifying those who do.

ARTICLE IV. MEMBERS

This corporation shall be organized on a nonstock basis.

The qualifications for members and the manner of their admission shall be as set forth in the by-laws.

ARTICLE V. PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The initial principal office shall be 3332 Corby Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32205.

ARTICLE VI. REGISTERED AGENT

The initial registered agent shall be A. Reginald Taylor, III, and the address of the initial registered office shall be 3332 Corby Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32205.

ARTICLE VII. DIRECTORS

The initial board of directors shall have three directors whose names and addresses are as follows:

The manner in which directors shall be elected or appointed shall be as set forth in the By-Laws.

ARTICLE VIII. Incorporator

ARTICLES IX. Restrictions

No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Third hereof.

No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these

articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

ARTICLE X. Dissolution

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision of the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is the located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such

purposes.
