ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of the Corporation is "And Justice For All", The Emma Lazarus Foundation Inc.

ARTICLE II

ENABLING LAW

The Corporation is organized pursuant to the Corporations Not For Profit law of the State of Florida, set forth in Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSES

- 1. The specific and primary purpose for which the Corporation is formed is:
- (a) To promote a public policy debate regarding policies and programs which attempt to reduce immigration into the United States and the State of Plorida.

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- (b) To support measures which promise to reduce illegal immigration into the United States and the State of Florida without compromising individual rights and community well-being.
- (c) To oppose ill-concaived proposals which will not reduce illegal immigration but will threaten the health and safety of Floridians.
- (d) Engage in research and public education in pursuit of these goals.
- (e) to operate exclusively in any other manner for such charitable and educational purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or under any corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, covering the distributions to organizations qualified as tax exempt organizations under the Internal Revenue Code, including private foundations and private operating foundations.
- 2. The Corporation shall have and exercise all rights and powers conferred upon corporations under the laws of the State of Florida; provided, however, that the Corporation is not empowered to engage in any activity that in itself is not in furtherance of its purposes as set forth in subparagraphs (a) through (e) of this article.

ARTICLE IV

TERM

The Corporation shall have a perpetual existence.

The corporation shall have no memebers. furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles of Incorporation.

- (c) Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles of Incorporation, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code or (iii) by a non-profit corporation organized under the laws of the State of Florida.
- (d) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of the Corporation.

ARTICLE X

BYLANS

Bylaws will be hereinafter adopted at the first meeting of the Board of Directors. Such bylaws may be amended or repealed, in whole or in part, by the Board of Directors in the manner provided

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purpose of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable or educational, purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under action 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a Court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as such Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
