Florida Statues 617.0301 of Purposes and application are in force with exception to paragraph 6, which is retained to the power of the President soley for appointing the whole of the board of directors. Termination of a member in good standing must have the approval of at least 2/3 of the total board of directors. Exception is the President who cannot be terminated except by his or her own hand. The member must have the right to appeal the discision of the board before it goes public by written notice delivered by registered mail. Notice must be

no longer than 30 days from the vote to remove same. Appeal must be made no later than 30 days after the mail has been recieved in writting to the board of directors address. A board of director (except the President) can be removed by the President at any time and to appoint one as well. No one will be removed because of a personality conflict with other parties. A grivence committee will be activated if needed, of three people from the board of directors and the President. They in turn will make a motion to the board of directors of their findings. (4)

There is no transfer of membership, unless the Bradenton Computer Club joins or mergers with another not for profit organization.

In the event of dissolution, the remaining board of directors and the President will make the descision after all the indebitedness is met, to where the remainder of the funds and property will go. First and foremost the regard for charities will be considered. Then most any educational not for profit organization will be next in line.

Anyone who is a member in good standing of the Bradenton Computer Club, has no rights of interest to or right of ownership of club property. A member in good standing has the privilege to attend special interest groups and meetings.

The initial members are the board of directors. Everyone is entitled to be a member no matter what his or her affilition. (8)

The Bradenton Computer Club is in no way responsible to any other corporation nor is it subject to any authority other than the laws of the United States or the State of Florida.

The President is the only one who can change the bylaws, unless he or she would die, then article VII section 10 will apply.

Florida Statues 617.0302 Corporate Powers, Number 6 is not in force. The President is the only one who can appoint and increase the number of directors, except in case of death the wife of the president will either take over or appoint someone else. Or on retirement the president will appoint someone else.
