## ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this corporation is L.E.G.A.C.Y. of South Florida, Inc. , a corporation not for profit

# ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL OFFICE

## ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

To develope a better quality of life on earth for future generations by creating a natiowide network of volunteers willing to donate time, expertise & resources to the preservation, conservation and rehabilitation of the environment, and conduct research into more efficient source s of energy.

#### ARTICLE IV - QUALIFICATION OF MEMBERS

Each person must be willing to donate sufficient time into developing the network of volunteers to furthe the corporate purpose.

This corporation shall have three (3) Directors constituting the initial Board of Directors. # ARTICLE VIII - BOARD OF DIRECTORS ELECTIONS

The Board of Directors shall be elected by the membership at each annual meeting of the members.

#### ARTICLE IX - OFFICERS

The legal affairs of the corporation shall be managed by the officers who shall be elected at the annual meeting each year to serve for the ensuing year. The officers of the corporation shall serve until their respective successors in office shall be elected and duly qualified.

#### ARTICLE X - REVENUE

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Revenue Law).

#### ARTICLE XI - DISSOLUTION

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, The Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated for charitable, educational, religious, or exclusively scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as organization or organizations under Section exempt 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any of such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the Circuit Court of the County in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.


