ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, the undersigned residents and citizens of the United States of America of full age of majority, have for the purpose of forming a not for profit religious corporation pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act, for the purposes expressed in Article III hereof, adopted the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the Corporation is Flame Ministries, Inc., and its duration is to be perpetual effective with the filing with the Secretary of State on March 25, 1996, whichever is earlier.

ARTICLE II

The name of the registered agent and the location and address of the Corporation's registered office in the State of Florida is, Anita K. Bing, Esq. 6850 Living Water Place, Tampa, FL. 33610. The street and mailing address if the principal office of the Corporation is 6850 Living Water Place, Tampa, FL. 33610.

ARTICLE III

This Corporation is organized Not for Profit and is organized and operated exclusively for exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 as amended, including the following purposes:

- A. Religious;
- B. Minister the Word of God to the faithful;
- C. Conduct a religious worship service through various forms of ministry;

carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by:

- (1) A corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(C)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law); or
- (2) By a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170 (C)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provisions of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).

B. The Board of Trustees may cause the Corporation to solicit, collect, receive, accumulate, administer and disburse funds in such manner as will, in the sole discretion of the Board of Trustees, most effectively operate to further the purposes of the Corporation.

C. Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Trustees shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all of the liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all of the assets of the Corporation exclusively for the purpose of the Corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as a religious organization and a "Public Charity" under Section 501(C)(3) AND 509(A)(1) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), or to an organization contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(C)(2) of such Code and Regulations as they now exists or as they may hereafter be amended, as the Board of Trustees shall determine. Any such assets not disposed of shall be disposed of by the District Court of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to an organization or

D. Promote and encourage, through the ministry of the organization, cooperation with other organizations ministering within the community;

E. Spread the Word of the Gospel through seminars, television, radio and other forms of mass media for the purpose of educating the individual in the Word of God;

F. To acquire and hold such property, either real or personal, for Church purposes as may be necessary for its membership in the worship of God;

G. To provide educational services;

H. To engage in any lawful business or activities related thereto; and to engage in any lawful act or activity for which corporations may be organized under the Florida Corporation Code.

ARTICLE IV

This Corporation shall have no membership. The governing body of the Corporation shall be its Board of Trustees. The manner in which the Trustees shall be elected or appointed shall be fixed by the Bylaws.

ARTICLE V

This nonprofit Corporation is formed without any purpose of pecuniary profit and shall have no capital stock.

ARTICLE VI

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustee, officer, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to be paid reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article III hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the organization as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for purpose described in Section 501(C)(3) of the Code (or any corresponding future provisions).

ARTICLE VII
