The undersigned, acting as incorporator, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes adopt the following Articles of Incorporation

ARTICLE I

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized is herein set forth: The Mission of the FOUNDATION FOR TECHNOLOGICAL EDUCATION shall be to expand our technological expertise and engage in projects covering ages elementary to Senior citizens. The Foundation will supplement the use of traditional education approaches from the printed word to A/V techniques, utilizing them in concert with state-of-the-art technology.

The Foundation plans to expand the perceived perimeters of the classroom and engage in cooperative education and historical projects with the other non-profit, University, educational television, and select internet groups. Special attention will be given to family oriented projects at the home and community level.

The Foundation will provide assistance with technological techniques to other professional groups and monitor results if requested. We will use our expanded knowledge to enhance educational approaches used for special education students and will strive to assist senior citizens and minority groups to participate actively in our technological society.

ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

to

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

THE FOUNDATION FOR TECHNOLOGICAL EDUCATION, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 617.1006, Florida Statutes, the undersigned corporation adopts the following articles of amendment to its articles of incorporation.

FIRST: Amendments adopted:

ARTICLE III is amended by adding the following:  
The purposes for which the corporation is organized are exclusively scientific, literary and educational and Patriotic within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE V is amended to read:

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or any corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

ARTICLE VIII is added to the Articles:

ARTICLE VIII. Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purpose within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax Code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, State or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction, in the county, in which the principal office of the organization is located, exclusively for such purpose.

SECOND: The date of adoption of the amendments was October 11, 1996.

THIRD: Adoption of the Amendments:
