In compliance with the requirements of Chapter 617,
Florida Statutes, the undersigned, who is a resident of Brevard
County, Florida who is of full age, has this day voluntarily
associated himself together for the purpose of forming a
corporation not-for-profit and does hereby certify as follows:

ARTICLE I
CORPORATE NAME

The name of the corporation is BREVARD COUNTY CLAIMS
ASSOCIATION, INC., hereinafter called the "Corporation".

ARTICLE II
PURPOSES AND GENERAL POWERS

A. This Corporation is formed primarily to establish
professional standards amongst claims adjusters to provide
educational services to the general public concerning the proper
administration of insurance claims, to promote and educate
members of the insurance claims industry concerning standards of
ethics in Brevard County, Florida and incident to such purposes
is intended to provide a full range of services to the general
public and its members concerning the insurance claims industry.

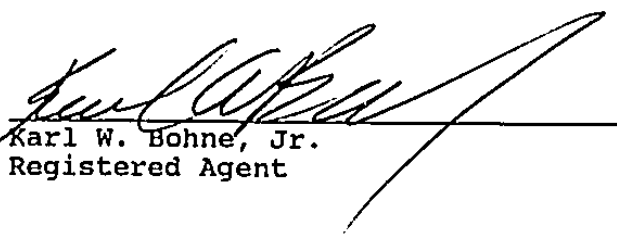
