Wo, the undersigned incorporators, each natural person competent to contract, hereby associate ourselves together to form and establish a corporation NOT FOR PROFIT under the laws of the State of Florida.

FIRST:

The name of the corporation is EGLISE BAPTISTE MISSIONNAIRE DE MIAMI, INC., (MISSIONARY BAPTIST CHURCH OF MIAMI, INC.,

SECOND:

The location of its principal place of business in this State is 10 N.E. 124th Terrace, Miami, Florida 33161.

THIRD:

The location of its registered agent in this State is 121 N.E. 23rd Court, Pompano Beach, Florida 33060.

FOURTH:

The name of the registered agent of this corporation is PASTOR ANDRE POITEVIEN.

FIFTH:

This corporation is organized NOT FOR PROFIT and the object, and purposes to be transacted and carried on are:
