BEARST ARMISH

THE UNDERSIGNED SUBSCRIBER, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation for the formation of a non-profit corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation is PANHANDLE ACADEMIC COMMITTEE FOR EDUCATION, INC., and the initial principal address of the corporation is 2902-B Harrison Avenue, Panama City, Florida 32405.

ARTICLE II

The period of duration is perpetual unless the corporation is dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE III

The purpose of the corporation, a not-for-profit charitable organization, is to advance the lives of youth in Bay County, Florida, by expanding their educational opportunities, physical activities and social wellbeing through a joint venture among the youth and parents, educators, community leaders, business entities and other friends of youth. The Corporation is organized and operated exclusively for charitable purposes and no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any private individual. The Corporation shall have the power to do all lawful acts necessary or desirable to carry out its purposes consistent with the provisions of the Florida Statutes and Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, a amended.

ARTICLE IV

The Corporation shall distribute its income for each tax year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject

to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The Corporation shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The Corporation shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The Corporation shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under Section 34944 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. The Corporation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

ARTICLE V

Membership in the Corporation shall be pursuant to the By-Laws provided.

ARTICLE VI

The address, including street and number, of the initial registered office of this Corporation is 2902-B Harrison Avenue, Panama City, Florida, 32405, and the name of its initial Registered Agent at such address is Derrick Lane.

ARTICLE VII

The number of Directors shall not be less than three (3) and no more than fifteen. The number of Directors may be increased and diminished from time to time by the By-Laws, but shall never be less than three. Directors shall be elected or appointed as provided in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VIII

This Corporation shall have no stock and is not authorized to issue capital stock.

ARTICLE IX

The internal affairs of the Corporation shall be governed by the provisions contained in the By-Laws of the Corporation. The Chairman of the Board of Directors shall be responsible for the day-to-day operation of the Corporation. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, any assets remaining after the satisfaction of all corporate liabilities shall be conveyed to such organization or organizations as shall be selected by the affirmative vote of a majority of the Directors, provided, however, that such organization or organization must be recognized as exempt from federal income taxation under Sections 501(c)(3) and 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or corresponding sections of any prior or future law, or to the federal, state or local government for exclusive public purposes.
