# ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

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# SOUTH COUNTY COMMUNITY HOUSING CORPORATION

The undersigned subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation is natural person competent to contract and hereby form a non-profit Corporation under Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes.

# ARTICLE 1 - NAME

The name of the Corporation is SOUTH COUNTY COMMUNITY HOUSING CORPORATION, (hereinafter "Corporation").

# **ARTICLE 2 - PURPOSE OF CORPORATION**

- 2.1 The Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, religious, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.
- 2.2 The Corporation is organized for charitable and educational purposes to meet the housing needs of and improve the housing and related social services offered to low and moderate income residents of the City of Sarasota and throughout Sarasota County, Florida, including, without limitation, the Cities of Venice, Northport and those unincorporated areas of Sarasota County known as Laurel, Nokomis and Englewood. The Corporation shall be empowered to take such steps as are necessary to promote those ends, including, but not limited to the following:
- A. To develop and carry out property rehabilitation and/or new construction programs so that neighborhoods and affordable housing may be developed through cooperative efforts by low and moderate income families in the community.
- B. To develop and carry out property rehabilitation and/or new construction programs in order to increase the availability of affordable housing for low and moderate income families.
- C. To develop the needed expertise in the areas of property management, renovation and support services in order to provide cleaner and safer



housing facilities to and among low and moderate income families in the described community.

### **ARTICLE 3 - PROHIBITIONS**

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Second hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the Corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a Corporation exempt from faderal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or (b) by a Corporation, contributions to which are deductible under section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

#### **ARTICLE 4 - DIRECTORS**

The Directors shall be elected by a majority vote of the Members of this Corporation. The Corporation shall have nine (9) Directors. The Initial Directors of the Corporation shall be:

# ARTICLE 8 - TERM OF EXISTENCE

This Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

#### ARTICLE 9 - CAPITAL STOCK

This Corporation shall have no capital stock and shall be composed of members rather than shareholders.

# **ARTICLE 10 - QUALIFICATIONS OF MEMBERSHIP**

The categories of membership, qualifications for membership and the manner of admission shall be as set forth in and regulated by the By Laws of the Corporation.

#### **ARTICLE 11 - VOTING RIGHTS**

Members of the Corporation will have such voting rights as are provided in the By Laws of the Corporation.

### **ARTICLE 12 - LIABILITIES FOR DEBTS**

Neither the members nor the members of the Board of Directors or officers of the Corporation shall be liable for the debts of the Corporation.

# ARTICLE 13 - REGISTERED OFFICE AND REGISTERED AGENT

These Articles of Incorporation shall be effective immediately upon approval of the Secretary of State, State of Florida.



## **ARTICLE 15 - AMENDMENT**

Those Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by law. Every amendment shall be approved by the Board of Directors, proposed by them to the Members, and approved at a Members meeting by a majority of the Members, unless all the Directors and all the Members sign a written statement manifesting their intention that a certain amendment of these Articles of Incorporation be made.

#### **ARTICLE 16 · DISSOLUTION**

Upon dissolution of the Corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exampt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government for public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by Court of Competent Jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the Corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
