## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION of FLORIDA WINGS FOR CHILDREN, INC.

FIRST: The name of the corporation is Florida Wings for Children, Inc.

SECOND: The location and address of its registered office in this State is 116 Edgemere Way South, Edgemere, Naples, Florida 33999.

The initial registered agent and street address is: M. Richard Mellon, 116 Edgemere Way South, Edgemere, Naples, Florida 33999.

THIRD: The purposes for which the Corporation is organized are exclusively charitable, scientific or educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and includes all purposes, powers and privileges conferred upon the Corporation by the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, as well as the more specific purpose of working with and for terminally ill children who have an interest in flying.

FOURTH: The Corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise.

FIFTH: The Corporation is incorporated under the provisions of the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act.

SIXTH: The Corporation shall have no capital stock.

SEVENTH: The Corporation shall be a membership organization of which the sole corporate member shall be Wings for Children, Inc., a Pennsylvania nonprofit corporation.

EIGHTH: The management of the Corporation shall be vested in a Board of Directors in the specific number to be fixed by the Bylaws and to be selected and constituted from time to time as provided in the Bylaws of the Corporation.

NINTH:

Personal Liability of Directors

To the fullest extent that the laws of the State of Florida currently in effect, or as thereafter amended, permit elimination or limitation of the liability of Directors, no Director of the Corporation shall be personally liable for monetary damages as such for any action taken, or any failure to act, as a Director. Any amendment or repeal of this Article or adoption of any Bylaw which has the effect of increasing Director liability shall operate prospectively only and shall not affect any action taken, or any failure to act, prior to its adoption.

TENTH: (a) No substantial part of the activities of the Corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.

(b) No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its Directors, Officers or other private persons except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth herein.

(c) Notwithstanding any other provisions set forth herein, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (i) by a corporation exempt from Federal Income Tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws, or (ii) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible for Federal income tax purposes.

ELEVENTH: In the event of dissolution, liquidation or termination of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provisions for the payment of all the liabilities of the Corporation, distribute all assets of the Corporation to such organization or organizations as they, in their sole discretion, shall select consistent with the purposes and goals of the Corporation; provided, however, that such organization or organizations shall, at the time of such distribution, qualify as an organization or organizations described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986.
