## ARTICLE I

The name of this corporation is FUNDACION UNIVERSIDAD DE SAM JOSE INC.

## ARTICLE II

#### ARTICLE III PURPOSES

- A. This corporation is organized and shall operate exclusively for religious, charitable, educational, literary, and scientific purposes but limited to exempt purposes described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law); and this Corporation may engage in only such activities permitted under the laws of the State of Florida and the United States of America as shall constitute furtherance of such exempt purposes. The Corporation may have two or more classes of members, including regular voting members, nonvoting members, and honorary members, as well as such other classes of members as may be determined under the By-laws.
