A CORPORATION NOT FOR PROFIT

The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation not for profit pursuant to Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of the corporation shall be:

ARTICLE II - PRINCIPAL PLACE OF BUSINESS AND MAILING ADDRESS

The address of the principal office of this corporation shall be 300 Sevilla Avenue, Suite 304, Coral Gables, Florida 33134, and the mailing address of the corporation shall be the same.

ARTICLE III - PURPOSE

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in sections 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose.

The specific purposes of the corporation are the coordination and channeling of aid to the sick, handicapped and poor of North America, Central America and South America, and to promote the health, welfare, education and development of the sick, aged, poor and handicapped, regardless of race, color or creed.
