Articles of Incorporation

of

FLORIDA ASSOCIATION OF MOBILE SELF-CONTAINED STORAGE UNITS, INC. PHIZE 2

A Not for Profit Corporation

ARTICLE ONE - NAME

The name of this corporation is FLORIDA ASSOCIATION OF MOBILE SELF-CONTAINED STORAGE UNITS, INC.

ARTICLE TWO - PURPOSE

This corporation is formed for the purpose of organizing the mobile self-contained storage unit operators in Florida who shall be its members, to offer education and training relating to the industry, as well as business networking opportunities, and to facilitate the examination, consideration, promotion or opposition of issues of common concern to the corporation's members.

This corporation may engage in any activity permitted under the laws of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE THREE - INITIAL PRINCIPAL OFFICE

The initial principal office of the corporation shall be in care of Robert C. Harris, 335 Beard Street, Tallahassee, FL 32303.

ARTICLE FOUR - ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

The method for the election of directors shall be stated in the By-Laws of the corporation.

ARTICLE FIVE - ORGANIZATION ON NON-STOCK BASIS

This corporation is organized on a non-stock basis and will not issue capital stock to its members. Memberships in the corporation shall not be transferable.

ARTICLE SIX - INITIAL REGISTERED AGENT

The name and street address of the initial registered agent of this corporation is Robert C. Harris, 335 Beard Street, Tallahassee, FL 32303.

ARTICLE SEVEN - BY-LAW PROVISIONS

The corporation may adopt By-Laws to regulate the internal affairs of the corporation in respect to relative rights of its members, the manner of termination of membership, the rights,

if any, of terminated members, the creation of classes of members, and in respect to any other provisions allowed by law. By-Laws shall be adopted by and may be amended by the vote or written consent of a majority of all the members.

ARTICLE EIGHT - INDEMNIFICATION

The corporation shall indemnify any officer or director, or any former officer or director, to the full extent permitted by law.

ARTICLE NINE - INCORPORATOR

ARTICLE TEN - AMENDMENT

This corporation reserves the right to amend or repeal any provisions contained in these Articles of Incorporation in accordance with the provisions of the Florida Not for Profit Corporation Act.
