I pon the dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exercise purposes within the meaning of section 501 (e.i.3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal fax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose Any such assets no disposed of shall be disposed of by the Court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the organization or organizations as and Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
