**ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
A FLORIDA NON PROFIT CORPORATION**

ARTICLE I NAME

The name of the Corporation is C & E OUTREACH INCORPORATED

ARTICLE II. DURATION

The duration of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III PURPOSE

The purpose of the corporation is as follows:

A. This corporation is a not-for-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person. The specific purpose of this corporation is to increase public understanding of youth and families and the effects of contemporary social problems- including but not limited to HIV infection, alcoholism and drug dependency, mental illness, developmental disability, illiteracy - on the family.

B. To provide and manage a comprehensive range of prevention, intervention, education treatment, and supportive services related to children, youth and families.

C. To engage in any and all lawful business, trades, occupations or professions not incompatible with those listed above.

D. The purposes for which C & E Outreach is organized are exclusively religious, charitable, scientific, literary, and educational within the meaning of section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.

Upon the dissolution of the corporation, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of section 501(c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such

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assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by the court of Common Pleas of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said Court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.

E. Provided, however, that the corporation shall not engage in any action which is not permitted to be carried on by nonprofit corporations under the Internal Revenue Code and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to its members, directors, or officers; but the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation to these people for services rendered, and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its stated purposes.

ARTICLE IV MEMBERS

The corporation shall have voting members, who shall be elected by the Voting Members, and who shall have all the rights and privileges of members of the corporation. The Bylaws may provide for Nonvoting Members of one or more classes, who shall be admitted in such manner and who shall have such rights and privileges as are set forth in the Bylaws, but who shall not have the right to vote. The Bylaws shall provide the method of election of all Directors, and the number of Directors may be raised or lowered by amendment of the bylaws but shall in no case be less than three.

Each officer shall be elected by the Board of Directors at such time and in such manner as may be prescribed by the Bylaws. 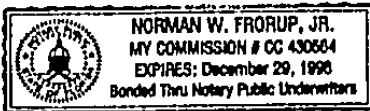
