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ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

LIVING CLASSROOMS OF FLORIDA, INC.

The undersigned, acting as Incorporators of a Florida not-forprofit corporation (the "Corporation"), organized under the laws of the State of Florida as contained in the "Florida Non-Profit Corporation Act", Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, as amended, does hereby adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for the said non-profit Corporation:

- 1. The name of the Corporation is LIVING CLASSROOMS OF FLORIDA, INC.
- 2. The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.
- 3. The general purpose or purposes for which the Corporation is initially organized is, but not limited to, the following:
 - A. To receive and to administer funds and to operate exclusively for religious, charitable, scientific, cultural, literary or educational purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or comparable provisions of subsequent legislation and to give funds and property from time to time to other organizations to be used or held for use directly in carrying out one or more such purposes.
 - B. To acquire, own, purchase, lease, dispose of and deal with real and personal property and interests, either absolutely or in trust therein and to apply gifts, grants, bequests, and devises and the proceeds thereof in furtherance of the purposes of the corporation.
 - C. To do such things and to perform such acts to accomplish its purposes as the Board of Directors may determine to be appropriate and as are not forbidden by Section 501(c)(3) of the code, with all powers conferred on nonprofit corporations under the laws of the State of Florida.
- 4. All corporate powers shall be exercised by and under the authority of, and the business and affairs of the corporation shall be managed under the direction of, the Board of Directors. Any and all of the powers and duties conferred to or imposed upon the Board of Directors shall be exercised or performed to such extent and by such person or persons as shall be provided by the Directors. The number of directors constituting the initial Board of Directors shall be three (3). The manner in which the directors are appointed may be as stated in the By-Laws.

These Articles of Incorporation may be amended at any time by a vote of the majority of the Board of Directors at any regular meeting of the Directors or at any special meeting of the Directors called for that purpose.
- 9. The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal bylaws shall be vested in the Board of Directors.
- 10. The date when corporate existence shall begin shall be the date of execution of these Articles of Incorporation by the undersigned, provided these Articles are filed with the Secretary of State within the time allowed by law.

13. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributed to its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay

reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article Three hereof. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of or in opposition to any

candidate for public office.

Notwithstanding any of the provision of these articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code, or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code or, shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

The assets of this corporation are irrevocably and 14. permanently dedicated to educational purposes. Upon the dissolution of the corporation, its assets shall be distributed to one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding section of any future federal tax code; or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction of the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization, or organizations, as such court shall determine, that are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
