

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

OTG PUBLISHING, INC.

A FLORIDA NONPROFIT CORPORATION

ARTICLE I

Name

The name of this corporation is OTG PUBLISHING, INC. The mailing address and initial principal office of the corporation is 3101 Southwest 34th Avenue, Ocala, Florida 34474.

ARTICLE II

Duration

The duration of this corporation shall be perpetual, commencing with the filing of these Articles of Incorporation with the Department of State of the State of Florida.

ARTICLE III

Purposes

The corporation is organized to engage in any lawful purpose or purposes not for pecuniary profit and not specifically prohibited to non-profit corporations under the laws of the State of Florida. The primary purpose for which this corporation is organized is to promote and encourage Florida tourism and public safety through education by providing to the public travel routes, points of interest, historical sites, amusement sites, rest stops, hotel and motel accommodations, dining establishments, safety travel information, emergency phone numbers, travel discounts, and dissemination of travel related news. Dedication of Assets

All of the funds and other property of this corporation and any monies or other benefits from its operations shall be used solely for the purposes of the corporation. No dividends shall be paid and no part of the income or profit of the corporation shall be distributed to directors, officers, or members except as reasonable compensation for services rendered to the corporation, as reimbursement for expenses incurred in connection herewith, or as benefits conferred upon members in conformity with the corporation's purposes.

ARTICLE V

Membership

The number of classes of members of the corporation and qualifications and rights of members of each class are set forth in the Bylaws.

ARTICLE VI

Location of Initial Registered Office and Name of Initial Registered Agent

ARTICLE VII

Initial Directors

The corporation is specifically authorized to make provisions for the indemnification of directors, officers, agents and employees to the fullest extent permitted by law.



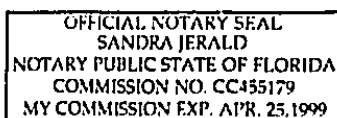
