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

ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

of

Senior Support Services, Inc.

A Florida Nonprofit Corporation

ARTICLE ONE, NAME

The name of this corporation is Senior Support Services, Inc.

ARTICLE TWO. STATEMENT OF CORPORATE NATURE

This is a nonprofit corporation organized solely for general charitable purposes pursuant to the Florida Not For Profit Corporation Act, Chapter 617, Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE THREE, PURPOSES

The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate for the advancement of charitable purposes, specifically including, to foster and facilitate the needs of elders and disabled individuals in need, to provide care, and to promote independence and/or higher quality of life, and for other charitable purposes, by the distribution of its funds for such purposes.

The general purposes for which this corporation is formed are to operate exclusively for such charitable purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations qualifying as tax-exempt organizations

under that Code.

This corporation shall not, as a substantial part of its activities, carry out propaganda or otherwise attempt to influence legislation; nor shall it participate or intervene (by publication or distribution of any statements or otherwise) in any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.

ARTICLE FOUR. DEDICATION OF ASSETS

The property of this corporation is irrevocably dedicated to charitable purposes and no part of the net income or assets of this corporation shall ever inure to the benefit of any director, officer, or member thereof, or to the benefit of any private individual.

ARTICLE FIVE, MEMBERSHIP

The corporation shall have a membership distinct from the board of trustees. Any person paying dues as provided for in the bylaws and agreeing to be bound by the articles of incorporation of this corporation, by its bylaws, and by such rules and regulations as the trustees may from time to time adopt, is eligible for membership in the corporation. The trustees shall from time to time prescribe the form and manner in which application may be made for membership.
