The undersigned, acting as incorporator of a corporation pursuant to Chapter 617, Florida Statute & ALLAhira Articles of incorporation:

### ARTICLE I Name

The name of the corporation shall be First Coast Teanis Foundation, Inc.

## ARTICLE II Principle place of business and mailing address

The principle place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be:

### ARTICLE III Purpose(s)

- 1.1 Purpose. The specific purpose for which the corporation is organized is to implement and operate a foundation exclusively for charitable and educational reasons and reasons of promoting public safety by combatting juvenile delinquency. The foundation's intention is to organize charitably-funded programs in which it will enable, encourage, and recruit the participation of underprivileged young junior tennis players and educate them in the game of tennis as a wholesome lifetime sport which will contribute to their self-esteem and human potential, provide them with healthy social, emotional, and educational outlets, and encourage peer and family participation among them. The foundation further intends to solicit and accept gifts of money and property in order to carry out the purposes and objectives of the foundation; to promote, develop, and hold events, productions, and activities for fund-raising purposes; to raise funds in furtherance of the non-profit teaching, coaching, and organizing of tennis; and to meet and salisfy the expenses thereof in a manner consistent with Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code. 1986, as amended.
- 1.2 Not-for-profit Organization. The foundation is organized exclusively for charitable and educational purposes and to promote public safety as a not-for-profit corporation. Its activities shall be conducted for the aforesaid purposes and in such a manner that no part of its net earnings shall inure to the benefit of any member, trustee, officer, or any other person, and no substantial part of the activities of which is carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting, to influence legislation except as otherwise provideed in Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, and which does not parlicipate in, or intervene in, (including the publishing or distributing of statements), any political campaign on behalf of (or in opposition to) any candidate for public office. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, and after payments of its just debts and liabilities, all remaining assets shall be distributed to Council or another organization or organizations involved in the promotion of tennis in the State of Florida and enjoying an exempt status under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended.

# ARTICLE IV Manner of election of directors

The manner in which the directors are elected or appointed shall be stated in the bylaws of the foundation.

# ARTICLE V Limitation of corporate powers

The corporate powers of this corporation are as provided in section 617.0302 of the Florida Statutes.
