

### FIRST: Amendments adopted:

Article 4 (amended)

A.The purpose for which the corporation is organized are exclusively, religious, charitable, scientific, literary and educational within the meaning of section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law.

- B. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 or the corrresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- C. Upon dissolution of the organization, assets shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of the section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986, or corresponding section of any future Federal tax code, or shall be distributed to the Federal, state, or local government for a public purpose. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction, is the county in which the principal office of the organization is then located, exclusively for such purpose.
- D. Any salaries, wages, together with fringe benefits or other forms of compensation (housing, transportation, and other allowances) paid to or provided the employees, directors or officers will not exceed a value which is reasonable and commensurate with the duties and working hours associated with such employment and with the compensation ordinarily paid persons with similar positions or duties.
- E. This corporation is a not-for-profit corporation organized under Chapter 617, Florida Statutes. It is not organized for the private gain of any person. The specific purposes of this corporation are as follows: To raise funds to cover the cost of mental health counseling or psychiatric care for adults and children in crisis who otherwise could not receive that care due to insufficient financial resources and lack of an insurance carrier. To provide neurological and psychiatric education to the general public to raise awareness about common mood disorders and their treatments. To provide information to the general public regarding the neural basis of drug addiction. To provide parenting assistance classes and support groups to families referred by other social service agencies. B. To exercise all rights and powers conferred by the laws of the State of Florida upon nonprofit corporations.
