ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

TALLAHASSEE FLORIDA

The undersigned, acting as incorporate(s) of a corporation pursuant to chapter 617, Florida Statutes, adopt(s) the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be God's Generation, Inc.

ARTICLE II Principal Place of Business and Mailing Address

The principal place of business and mailing address of this corporation shall be 16820 S W 109 Avenue, Miami, Florida, 33157.

ARTICLE III Purpose(s)

The Corporation is organized as a not-for-profit, charitable corporation and not for the private or pecuniary gain of any person or entity. The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

The Corporation shall have the power, only to the extent that its status as an organization exempt from federal income taxation under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Code (as it may be amended or superseded) is not affected or prejudiced in any way, indemnify and/or advance expenses to any person who was or is a director, officer, employee or agent of the corporation(or was or in which the corporation had or has a direct or indirect interest) for any and all liability, cost or expense incurred by such a person in connection with any claim, action or proceeding to which such person is party by reason of holding any such position with the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI Initial Registered Agent
