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Articles of Incorporation of

Puetro Boila Combinishen No. 1 Association, Inc. (a Philips morphisms and for profit)

In creder to form a superpotentian part for profit under the laws of the State of Pleydan, we, the uniterisigned, do hereby associate purposes face a superpotentian for the purposes become specified and to that used we do by these Arisins of Inscriporation set forth.

ARTICLE1

The same of the surporation shall be Fuerto Bello Condomination No. 1 Association, two, hereisables referred to se the "Association."

ARTICLELL

The priphes and injustives of the Assimilation shall be to administrative operation and annegament of Puerto Ballo Condomisium No I (the "Condomisium") in assimilation with the Floride Condomisium Act (the "Ant") spins laud alterned in Dude County, Floride described in Exhibit "A" established hereta and made a part hereof, in accordance with the rights reserved by Developer as constained in the Incination of County, Floride and to this to Condomisium No.1 recorded in the Public Reserve of Dade County, Floride and to perform the acts and duties incident to the administration, operation and management of such condominium in accordance with the terms, provisions, sensitive and authorizations of these Articles of incorporation, the Pylore of the Association to be adopted (the "Bylaws") and in the formal Deciaration at Condominium (the "Declaration") which with he resulted in the Public Receive of Dade County, Floride, when the land and the improvement thereof are astronament to the condominium form of unmarrialitical to own, operate, ancestion, lease, sell, manage, sonvey, made and otherwise deal with its land, the improvemental such other property, whether real analyte process, as may be an become part of the Condominium (the "Condominium Property") to the extern necessary or necessaries in the administration of the Condominium. The Association shall be conducted as a non-proof organization for the beautiful its manufacts.

ARTIC: E.III

The powers of the Association shall radicds and be governed by the following provisions:

- All of the powers and provious granted to corporations not for profit under the fewn pursuant to which this corporation is chartered.
- B. All of the powers reasonable and recessive to implement and effectuate the purposes of the Association, including, without limitation, the power, authority and right to:
 - Make and selected temporable rules and regulations governing and of the unid, sommon elements and limited structure elements is and of the Condomistant as such terms are defined in the Declaration.
 - 2. Lavy and entiret assessments against members of the Association to defray the summent expansion of the Condomization as provided in the Declaration and Pylawa including the power to levy and collect assessments for the purpose of paying assessments levied against units in the condomition by governmental entries and for the purpose of acquiring, auriting, boilding, operating, leasing, encountering, salling, conveying, exchanging, managing and otherwise dealing with the Condominum Property, including units, which may be reassesty of

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convenient in the operation and management of the condensitions and in accomplishing the purposes set forth in the Declaration. However, the Association may not oberge a use fee against a unit owner for the use of common alements or association property unless otherwise provided for in the Declaration of Condensiation or by a majority vote of the Association or unless the charges raints to appears incurred by an event being essiusive use of the common atemants or association property.

- Maintain, repair, replace, operate and manage the Condomintum Property including the right to reconstruct improvements after casualty and further to improve and add to the Condominium Property.
- 4. Contract for the management of the Condominium and in connection therewish, to delegate any and/or all of the powers and duties of the Americation to the extent and in the manner permitted by the Declaration, the Dylaws and the Act.
- Finterra the provisions of these Atticles of incorporation, the Declaration, the Bylone and all rules and regulations governing use of the Condominium which may from time to time establish.
- Contract, sue or the sund with respect to the exercise or mus-marcise of its powers. For these purposes, the powers of the Association include, but are not limited to, the maintenance, management and operation of the Condemisions Property. The Association may institute, maintain, eartie or appeal actions or beerings in its nects on behalf of all unit sweets concerning matter of common interest, including but not limited to, the common elements the roof and structural components of a building or other improvements mechanism, energical and plumbing elements serving on improvements or a building; representations of the developer pertaining to any entiting so proposed enumerally used facilities and protesting and valorate times on enumerally used facilities and on units; and may defend actions in exchant domain or bring savers condemistion any individual unit owner or class of wait owners to bring any exion which may otherwise he available.
- 7. The Association has the preventile right of excess to each unit during researchie hours, when necessary for the maintenance, repair or replacement of any common elements or for making energency repairs which are necessary to prevent damage to the common elements or to another unit or units.
- 8. Emercial, undertake and soccerplish all of the right, duties and obligations which may be granted to or improve upon the Association in the Destauration and the Act.
- 8. The Association has the power to acquere title to property or otherwise hold property for the use and benefit of its sureless. The power its require personal property skall be emittied by the Board of Administration. Emept as otherwise permitted in subsection 10 and 11 below, and is Plorida Statute 718.114, there shall be no acquisition of title to real property by the Association except in the manner provided in the declaration.
- iii. The Association has the power to purchase any land or recreation leave upon the approval of such voting interest as is required by the

declaration. If the declaration makes no processes for sequisition of the land or recreation lease, approved of the majority of voting interest shall be required to amount the declaration to permit the acquisition.

- 11. The Association has the prever, unless prohibited by the Decinration, Atticles of Incorporation on Bylaws of the Association, to purchase units in the consumnitum and to sequire and hold, lease, muritage, and convey them. There shall be no limitation on the Association's right to perchase a unit at a foreclosure sale resulting from the Association's foreclosure of its lies for unpaid assessments, or to take title by deed in New of terreclosure.
- 12. Unless prohibited by the declaration, the floated of Administration has the authority, without the jointeer of any unit weres, to grant, modify, or more any essential if the essential constitutes part of or creates the common elements or association property. This subsection does not suitorize the Board of Administration to modify, move, or vacate any essential ereated in whole or in part for the use or benefit of anyone other than the unit owners, or creating the property of anyone other hand owners, without the consent or approval of those other persons having the use or benefit of the essential, he required by law or by the instrument treating the essential. Nothing is this subsection affects the minimum requirements of Florida Sintate 718 104(4)(m) or the powers answersted in subsection 6.
- The Americation shall turn for best efforts to obtain and amuntant adequate insurance to protect the Association, the association property, the postmon elements, and the Condominium property required to be insered by the Association pursuant to paragraph 14. The association shall citizin and scaletain adequate fidelity building of all parsons who sontrol or disburss funds of the neucciation. As used in this section, the mrm "persons who countrol or disburse bonds of the association" muent those individuals authorized to sign thecks and the president, secretary and treasurer of the association. If an association's annual gross receipts do not exceed \$100,000, the bond shall be in the principal sum of not less than \$10,000 for each such person. If an association's samuel gross receipts exceed \$100,000, but not to exceed \$300,000, the bond shall be in the principal was of \$10,000, for each auch person. If an amordation's annual gross receipt exceeds \$300,000, the band shall be in the principal num of \$50,000, for each such person. The association shall bear the cost of the bonding and flood insurance for common elements, essociation property, and units. An association or group of associations ency self-insure against claims against the Association, the association property required to be treared by an Association, upon compliance with Florida Statute 624.460-624.488. A copy of each policy of tearrance in offset shall be made trailable for inspection by mait owners at reasonable times.
- 14. Every hexard policy which is issued to protest a condominium building, shall provide that the word "building" wherever used in the policy include, but not necessarily be limited to, fictures, installations, or additions comprising that part of the building within the unflatshed interior surfaces of the particular walls, floors, and callings of the individual units initially tawalled, or replacements thereof of the kind or quality, in accordance with the original plane and specifications, or as they axisted at the time the unit was initially conveyed if the original plans and specifications are not available. However, unless prior to October, 1, 1986, the Association is required by the declaration to provide coverage therefore, the word "building" does not include unit

dior coverings, well coverings, or ceiling coverings and as to Contracts entered into after January I, 1972, does not include the following equipment: electrical fixtures, appliances, air conditioning or licating equipment, water heaters, or bails in cablests. With respect to the coverage provided for by this paragraph, the unit owners shall be considered additional insured under the policy.

- 15. Byery insurance policy issued to an individual unit owner shall provide that the coverage attorded by such policy is excess over the amount recoverable under any other policy covering the same property without rights of subrogation against the Association.
- 16. With respect to condominiums ersated on or after October 1, 1924, the bylews shall include a provision granting the correlation a limited power to convey a portion of the owner alemans to a condemning authority for the purpose of providing villey consensult, right-of-way expansion, or other public purposes, whether negutiated or se a result of emment domain proceedings.

AUTICLELY

The qualification of members, the manner of their admission to and termination of membership and voting by members aball be as follows:

- A. The record owners of all units in the Condominium shall be members of the Association and no other persons or entities skall be entitled to membership, except as provided in Paragraph E, Article IV, hereof.
- C. Mambership shall be established by the acquisition of fee title to a unit in the Comboninium or in added units or by acquisition of a les ownership interest therein, by voluntary conveyance or operation of law and the membership of any person or entity shall be automatically terminated when such person or entity is divested of all title or his entire see consensip in such unit; provided that nothing herein contained shall be construed as terminating the membership of any person or entity owning fee title to or a fee ownership interest in two or more units at any time wille such person or entity shall retain the title to or a fee ownership laterest in any unit.
- C. The interest of a member in the funds and assets of the Association cannot be assigned, hypothecasted or transferred in any manner, except as an appartenance to the unit owned by such member. The funds and assets of the Association shall be expend, hald or used only for the benefit of the membership and for the purposes authorized herein, in the Declaration and in the Deleva.
- D. On all matters upon which the membership shall be att tied to vote, there shall be one vote, and only one vote, for each unft in the condominium, which vote may be enercised or past by the owner of each unit as may be provided in the Bylaws of the Association. Should say person or early own more than one unit, such mamber shall be entitled to enercise or can one vote for each such unit in the manner provided by the Bylaws.
- E. Ustil such time as the land and the improvements constructed thereon are submitted to the condominium form of ownership by excerdation of the Declaration in the Public Records of Dade County, Florida, the membership of the Association shall be comprised of the subscribers to these Articles each of whose shall be extitted to east one vote on all memors on which the membership shall be extitted to vote.

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ARTICLEY

The term of the Association shall be perpetual or if the condominium is terminated, the term shall and as soon after termination of the condominium as its affairs can be concluded

ARTICLE_VI

The principal office of the Association shall be located in Florida, but the Association may maintain offices and transact business in such places within or without the State of Florida as may from time to time be designated by the Board of Administration.

The affairs of the Association shall be comprised of three persons until such time as the Developer has conveyed title to all units is the Condominium. After such event occurs, the Doard of Administration shall be comprised of five persons. The members of the Board of Administration shall be elected by the members of the Association at the annual meeting of the membership as provided by the flylaws. The Board of Administration may amploy a managing agent, agency and/or other managerial and supervisory personnel or entity to administer or assist in the administration of the operation and management of the condominium and the affairs of the Association and any and all such persons and/or entities may be so employed without regard to whether any such person or eatily is a member of the Association or a member of the Board of Administration or officer of the Association, as the case may be.

The Board of Administration shall have a President, a Secretary and a Treasurer, and if so decided one or more assistants to such offices. The officers of the Association shall not subject to the direction of the Board of Administration and shall be elected by a majority of the Board of Administration. The President shall be elected from the membership of the Roard of Administration but no other officer need to be a member of the Board of Administration. The same person may hold two offices.

The Developer shall have the right to maintain control of the Association subject to the provisions of the Condominium Act and considering the fact that this Association is created for the purposes of operating and managing the condominium property.

ARTICLE VII

The name and address of the members of the first Board of Administration, who subject to the provisions of the laws of the States of Florida, these Articles of Incorporation and the Dylaws, shall hold office until their successors are elected and take possession, are as follows:

ARTICLE VIII

The officers of the corporation who shall hold office until their successors are elected pursuant to these Articles of Incorporation and the Bylaws shall be the following:

ARTICLEIX

The original Bylaws of the Association shall be adopted by a majority of the subscribers to these Articles of Incorporation at a meeting at which a majority of the subscribers is present, and thereafter, in order for such amendment to become effective, the same must be approved by an affirmative vote of the owners of units to which not less than soventy five per cent of the common elements are appurishent and a copy of such amendment to those bylaws shall be transcribed, certified by President and Secretary of the Association and a copy thereof shall incorporated into and Amendment of the Declaration and recorded in the Public Records of Dade County, Florida within thirty days from the date of which amendment have been affirmatively approved by the members.

ARTICLE X

Every member of the Board of Administration and every officer of the Association shall be indemnified by the Association against all expenses and liabilities, including counsel fors, reasonably incurred by or imposed upon him in connection with any proceeding or any solutement of any proceeding to which he may be a party, or is which he may become involved by reason of his being or having been a member of the Board of Administration or officer at the time auch expenses are incurred, except in such cases wherein the member of the Board of Administration or officer is adjudged guilty of wilkful miniscessnos or malfeasance in the performance of his duties; provided that, in the event of any claims for reimbursement or indemnification hereunder based upon a settlement by the member or officer seeking such roimbursement or indemnification, the indemnification herein shall apply only if the Board of Administration approves such settlement and reinbursement as being for the best interest of the Association. The foregoing right of indemnification shall be in addition to and not exclusive of all other rights which such member or officer may be antitled. The Association shall corry errors and omission insurance in favor of officers and members of the Board of Administration.

ARTICLE XI

As amendment or amendments to these Articles of Incorporation may be proposed by the Board of Administration or the Association assing upon a vote of the majority of the mainthers, or by the members of the Association assing upon a vote of the majority of the mainthers, or by the members of the Association owning a majority of the units in the condominium at that time declare or added, whether meeting as members or by instrument in writing signed by them. Upon any amendment or amendments to these Articles of incorporation being proposed by the Board or member, such proposed amendment shall be transmitted to the President of the Association or the acting chief executive officer in the absence of the President, who shall thereupon call a special meeting of the membership for a date not sooser than twenty days or later than sixty days from the receipt by him of the proposed amendment, and it shall be the duty of the Secretary to provide erch member written notice for such meeting stating the time and place of the meeting and reciting the proposed errandments in reasonable detailed form which notice shall be mailed or presented pursonally to each member not less than fourteen days nor more than thirty days before the

date set for such meeting. If meiled, such notice shall be deemed properly given when deposited in the United States mail, addressed to the member at his post office address as it appears on the records of the Association with postage thereon prepaid. Any member may, by written waiver of notice agned by such member, waive such notice and such waiver whon filled in the records of the Association whether before, during or after the holding of the menting, shall be deemed equivalent to the giving of such notice to such member. At such anosting the amendment proposed must be approved by an affirmative vote of the member owning not less than two-thirds of the units in the condominium is order for such amendment to become effective. Thereupon, such amendments of these articles of incorporation shall be transcribed and certified in such form as may be necessary to file the same in the office of the Secretary of the State of Florids. A certified copy of each such minendment shall be recorded in the Public Records of Dade County, Florids within thirty days from the date on which the same is filed in the office of the Secretary of State. Notwithstanding the incorporation which shall abridge, amend or after the right of the Developer to designate and select members of the Beard of Administration, may be adopted or become effective without the prior written consent of Developer.

ARTICLE XII

- When unit owners other than the developer own 15 percent or more of the units in a condominium that will be operated ultimately by an association, the unit owners other than the developer shall be entitled to elect no less than one-direct of the members of the board of administration of the association. Unit owners other than the developer are entitled to elect not less than a majority of the mambers of the board of administration of an association:
 - Three years after 50 percent of the units that will be operated ultimately by the association have been conveyed to purchasers;
 - Three months after 90 percent of the units that will be operated altimately by the association have been conveyed to purchasers;
 - c) When all the units that will be operated ultimately by the association have been completed, some of them have been conveyed to purchasers, and none of the others are being offered by sale by the developer in the ordinary course of business:
 - d) When some of the units have been conveyed to purchasers and none of the others are being constructed of offered for sale by the developer in the ordinary course of business; or
 - e) Seven years after recordation of the declaration of condominium; or, in the case of an association which may ultimately operate more than one condomisium, 7 years after recordation of the declaration for the first condominium it operates; or, in the case of an association operating a phase condominium created pursuant to s. 718,403, 7 years after recordation of the declaration fressing the initial plane, whichever occurs first. The developer is entitled to elect at least one member of the board of administration of an association as long as the developer holds for sale in the ordinary operas of business at least 5 percent, in condominiums with fewer than 500 units, and 2 percent, in condominiums with more than 500 units, of the units in a condominium operated by the association. Pollowing the time the developer relinquishes control of the association, the developer may exercise the right to vote any developer-owned units in the same manner as any other unit owner except for purposes of reacquiring control of the association or selecting the majority members of the board of administration,.

- 2. At the time unit owners other than the developer elect a majority of the members of the board of administration of an association, the developer shall relinquish control of the association, and the unit owners shall accept control. Simultaneously, or for the purposes of paragraph (s) not more than 90 days therauther, the developer shall deliver to the association, at the developer's expense, all property of the unit owners and of the association which is held or controlled by the developer, including, but not limited to, the following terms, if applicable, as to each condomisium operated by the association:
 - a) The original or photocopy of the recorded deciaration of condominium and all amendments thereto. If a photocopy is provided, it shall be certified by affidavit of the developer or an officer or agent of the developer as being a complete copy of the actual recorded declaration.
 - A certified copy of the articles of incorporation of the arcoclation or, if the association was created prior to the effective date of this act and it is not incorporated, supress of the document creating the association.
 - 3) A copy of the bylaws.
 - The minute broke, including all minutes, and other books and records of the association, if any.
 - 5) Any house rules and regulations which have been promulgated.
 - b) Resignations of officers and members of the board of administration who are required to resign because the developer is required to relinquish control of the association.
 - c) The financial records, including financial statements of the association through the date of the termover. The records shall be audited for the period from the incorporation of the association or from the period covered by the last abdit, if applicable, by an independent certified public accountant. All financial statements shall be prepared in accordance with generally accepted auditing standards, se prescribed by the Florida Board of Accountants, pursuant to chapter 473. The accountant performing the sadit shall examine to the extent necessary supporting documents and records, including the cash disbursements and related paid invoices to determine if expenditures were for association purposes and the billings, cash, receipts, and related records to determine that the developer was charged and paid the proper amounts of assessments.
 - d) Association Ands or carrol thereof.
 - a) All tangible personal property that is property of the association, which is represented by the developer to be part of the common elements or which is ostensibly part of the common elements, and an inventory of that property.
 - f) A copy of the pinns and specifications utilized in the construction or remodeling of improvements and the supplying of equipment to the condominium and in the construction and installation of all mechanical components serving the improvements and the site with a certificate in affidivit form of the developer or his agent or an architect or engineer authorized to precise in this state that such plans and specifications represent to the best of his knowledge and belief, the actual plans and

specifications utilized in the construction and improvement of the condominium property and for the construction and installation of the mechanical components serving the improvements. If the condominium property has been declared a condominium more than 3 years after the completion of construction or restocicling of the improvements, the requirements of this peragraph do not apply.

- A list in the names and addresses, of which the developer had knowledge at any time in the development of the condominium, of all contractors, subcontractors, and suppliers utilized in the construction or remodeling of the improvements and in the landscaping of the condominium or association property.
- h) Insurance policies.
- Copies of any certificates of occupancy which may have been issued for the condominium property.
- Any other permits applicable to the condominium property which have been issued by governmental bodies and are in force or were issued whilin 1 year prior to the date the unit owners other than the developer take control of the secociation.
- All written warrantee of the contractor, subcontractor, suppliers, and manufactures, if any, that are still effective.
- A zoeter of unit owners and their addresses and telephone numbers, if known, as shown on the developer's recorder.
- m) Lesses of the common elements and other lesses to which the association is a party.
- n) Employment contracts or service contracts in which the association is one of the contracting parties or service contracts in which the association or unit owners have an obligation or responsibility, directly or indirectly, to pay some or all of the fee or charge of the person or parsons performing the service.
- o) All other contracts to which the association is a party.

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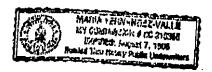
