ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

BELLE M. DEITCH CHARITABLE FOUNDATION, INC.
A NONPROFIT CORPORATION

We, the undersigned, with other persons being desirous, of forming a nonprofit corporation, under the provisions of Chapter 617 of the Florida Statutes, do agree to the following:

ARTICLE 1.

The name of the corporation shall be:

THE BELLE M. DEITCH CHARITABLE FOUNDATION, INC.

The principal place of business of this corporation shall be 21301 Powerline Road, #204, Boca Raton, FL 33433.

ARTICLE II.

exclusively for religious, charitable and educational purposes within the meaning of Sec. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code and its Regulations as they now exist or as they may be hereafter amended, and it is authorized to receive and maintain funds, to have, hold, manage and sell the same, to change the investments the proceeds thereof, and to collect and receive the income and profits thereof; and to apply the income and principal to the aid and assistance of any and all educational organizations and institutions, and to do all things that may be necessary and useful in the accomplishment of the purposes hereinabove set forth.

- (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue law.
- the purposes hereinabove set out, including the payment of expenses incidental thereto, and no part of the net earnings shall insure to the benefit of any part of the net earnings shall insure to the benefit of any private member or individual, and no substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be for the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation. In the event of dissolution, all assets and earnings shall be paid over to another corporation or corporations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, purposes which would qualify under the provisions of Sec. 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code as they now exist or as they may be hereafter amended.
 - (d) Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles:
- 1. The Corporation shall distribute its income for each tax year at such time and in such manner as not to become subject to the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.
- The Corporation shall not engage in any act of selfdealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code

of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.

- 3. The Corporation shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in section 4943 (c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.
- 4. The Corporation shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject it to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.
- 5. The Corporation shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the internal Revenue Code of 1986, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent Federal tax laws.

The Corporation shall have no capital stock and the private property of the incorporators and members shall not be liable for the debts of the Corporation.

ARTICLE III.

The membership of this corporation shall constitute all persons hereinafter names as officers and directors and such other persons as from time to time may become members by approval of the Board of Directors.
