ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
of
FLORIDA ARTS & CULTURAL EDUCATION, INC.
A FLORIDA CORPORATION NOT FOR PROFIT

This shall be a nonprofit corporation organized solely for the purpose of forming a corporation pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 617, Florida Statutes, and for those purposes they adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name and physical address of the principal office, and mailing address of the corporation are:

Florida Arts & Cultural Education, Inc., 2937 Beach Blvd., Gulfport, Florida 33707.

ARTICLE II

DURATION

This corporation shall have a perpetual existence; and the corporate existence will commence on the filing of these articles by the Department of State.

ARTICLE III

PURPOSE

The general purposes for which this corporation is organized are:

(a) to educate, promote and encourage the establishment and maintenance of the arts and culture.

(b) to acquire, renovate and administer the historic Patron's Inn.

(c) to promote the interests and welfare of public charities that have tax-exempt status under Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, or any corresponding provision of any federal income tax law enacted in substitution of that Code.

ARTICLE IV

DIRECTORS

The business affairs of this corporation shall be managed by the Board of Directors. The number of directors may be increased or decreased from time to time by the Bylaws but shall never be less than six (6). The names and addresses of the persons who shall serve as initial directors until the first election is held are as follows:

ARTICLE V

MEMBERSHIP

The Corporation shall have members. The qualifications of such members of the Corporation and the manner of their admission shall be regulated by the bylaws.

ARTICLE VI

INCORPORATOR

The name and address of the incorporator of this corporation is JAMES LODATO, Post Office Box 430, Nobleton, Florida 34661.

ARTICLE VII

INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial resident office of this corporation is 27429 Highway 54 West, Wesley Chapel, Florida 33544, and the name of the initial registered agent of this

corporation is Jacob I. Reiber.

ARTICLE VIII

DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

No part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, trustees, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered, and to make payments and distributions in furtherances of its charitable purpose.

ARTICLE IX

AMENDMENT

The Articles of Incorporation may be amended in the manner provided by its Bylaws.

ARTICLE X

BY-LAWS

The power to adopt, alter, amend or repeal by-laws shall be vested in the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE XI

DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS UPON LIQUIDATION

Upon the dissolution of the Corporation, its assets shall be distributed to a charitable organization that meets the requirement of Section 501 (c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended, or any corresponding provision of any federal income tax law enacted in substitution of that Code.

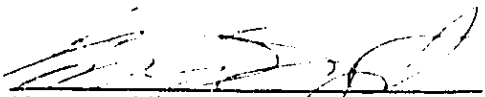
