ARTICLES OF AMENDMENT

FILED
SECRETARY OF STATE
DIVISION OF CORPORATIONS
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1. The following provisions of the Article of Incorporation of New Destiny Christian Center^(Church) Inc., a Florida Not for Profit Corporation filed in Tallahassee, Florida on June 13, 1996 hereby are amended in the following particulars:

Article III, **PURPOSES** be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

- a. To operate as a religious organization, specifically to operate as a church. To hold at least (2) two weekly services, where we will minister the gospel as written in the Holy Bible.
 - b. The purpose for which the corporation is formed is for religious, educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501 C (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future U.S. Internal Code Law.
 - c. Notwithstanding any other provisions of these articles, this organization shall not carry on any activities not permitted to be carried on by an organization exempt from Federal Income Tax under section 501 C (3) of the Internal Revenue code of 1986 or the corresponding provision of any future U.S. Internal Revenue Law.
2. The foregoing amendment was adopted by the Board of Directors of New Destiny Christian Center^(Church) Inc., on the 25th day of May 2000. The foregoing amendment does not require the vote/approval of the membership of the corporation.

ARTICLE VIII ARTICLE OF DISSOLUTION

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in section 501C (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.
