

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1. The following provisions of the Article of Incorporation of New Destiny Christian Center (Inc., a Florida Not for Profit Corporation filed in Tallahassee, Florida on June 13, 1996 hereby are amended in the following particulars:

Article III, PURPOSES be and it hereby is amended to read as follows:

- 2. The foregoing amendment was adopted by the Board of Directors of New Destiny Christian Center Inc., on the day of MAC 2000. The foregoing amendment does not require the vote/approval of the membership of the corporation.

## ARTICLE VIII ARTICLE OF DISSOLUTION

In the event of dissolution, the residual assets of the organization will be turned over to one or more organizations which themselves are exempt as organizations described in section 501C (3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or to the Federal, State, or local government for exclusive public purpose.
