ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF

A FLORIDA NON-PROFIT CORPORATION

The undersigned incorporator, who is a Florida resident who is able to contract and desiring to form a corporation under Chapters 607 of Florida statutes, adopt the following Articles of Incorporation:

ARTICLE I: NAME

The name of the Corporation shall be TACTICAL TRACKING OPERATIONS SCHOOL, INC.

ARTICLE II: PURPOSE

The purpose for which this corporation is organized and operated shall be to provide training sessions law enforcement officers in the tactical tracking of fugitives.
