ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CAREER WOMEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION, INC.

This corporation is being organized under the laws of the State of Florida and in particular Chapter 617, Corporations Not For Profit, Florida statutes, for the purposes detailed below and under the following Articles.

ARTICLE 1 - NAMF

The name of the corporation shall be CAREER WOMEN'S GOLF ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE II - PURPOSES

The corporation is organized for social and recreational purposes, specifically:

FIRST: To stimulate interest in golf by bringing together a group of golfers desirous of forming a golfing organization.

SECOND: To promote and foster among the members a closer bond and fraternity for their joint and mutual benefit, and to promote and preserve the best interests and true spirit of the game of golf as embodied in its ancient and honorable traditions.

THIRD: To provide an authoritative body to govern and conduct golf competitions, golf clinics and other golf related activities which are available exclusively to the membership and guests at cost.

ARTICLE III - MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the Career Women's Golf Association, Inc. (CWGA) is open to all female golfers 18 years or older. Types of membership shall be described in the bylaws.

ARTICLE IV - EXISTENCE

This corporation is to have a perpetual existence.

ARTICLE V - SUBSCRIBERS

The name and Post Office address of each subscriber to these Articles of Incorporation are listed below.

ARTICLE VI - MANAGEMENT

The business of the corporation shall be managed, controlled and conducted by a board of directors consisting of not less than four (4) nor more than fifteen (15) persons, the actual number to be specified in the bylaws. The officers of the corporation shall be elected by the board of directors. Qualifications and methodology for the election of members of the board of directors and the officers of the corporation shall be described in the bylaws.


