The undersigned, acting as the incorporator for the purpose of forming a Not For Profit Corporation, pursuant to Florida Statutes Chapter 617, adopts the following Articles of Incorporation.

ARTICLE I - NAME

The name of this Corporation is: United Youth Foundation, Inc.

ARTICLE II- PRINCIPAL CORPORATE ADDRESS

The principal corporate address of this Corporation is: 236 S.W. 22 Avenue, Miami, Florida 33135.

ARTICLE III NATURE OF BUSINESS

The general purposes for which this Corporation is organized are as follows:

- A. To conduct educational programs by providing the public community with information involving health care issues, including but not limited to the prevention of communicable diseases (including A.I.V.), increase awareness and availability of treatment programs and updated medical technology and advances. The forum used to discuss and debate these issues will occur via radio and consists of operating a noncommercial educational broadcast station.
- B. To receive and administer funds and to operate exclusively for educational, scientific, literary, charitable or religious purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the

Internal Revenue Code of 1986, or comparable provisions of subsequent legislation (hereafter "Code").

- C. To acquire, own, purchase, lease, dispose of and deal with real and personal property and interests, either absolutely or in trust therein and to apply gifts, grants, bequests, and devises and the proceeds thereof in furtherance of the purposes of the corporation.
- D. To do such things and to perform such acts to accomplish its purposes as the Board of Trustees may determine to be appropriate and are not forbidden by Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, with all the power conferred on Not For Profit Corporations in the State of Florida.

ARTICLE IV

The Corporation shall not issue shares of stock.

ARTICLE V TERM OF EXISTENCE

The Corporation shall exist perpetually unless dissolved according to law.

ARTICLE VI INITIAL REGISTERED OFFICE AND AGENT

The street address of the initial registered office of this Corporation in the State of Florida shall be: 501 Northeast 1st Avenue, Second Floor, Miami, Florida 33132.

ARTICLE VII

BOARD OF TRUSTEES

The powers of the Corporation shall be executed by or under the authority of and the business and affairs of the Corporation shall be managed under the direction of a Board of Trustees, which shall have eleven trustees (11) initially. The number of trustees may be increased or decreased by the trustees from time to time as provided in the By-Laws of the Corporation.

- 2. By affirmative vote of a majority of the trustees then in office and irrespective of any personal interest of any of

its members, the Board of Trustees shall have authority to establish reasonable compensation of all trustees for services to the corporation as trustees, officers, and otherwise.


