ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

FOR

CHRISTIAN FAMILY ALLIANCE, INC.

A NON-PROFIT CORPORATION



The undersigned incorporator, in order to form a non-profit corporation under the laws of the State of Florida adopts the following Articles of Incorporation:

ONE: The name of this corporation is Christian Family Alliance, Inc.

TWO: The name and address of the registered agent of this corporation and the principal place of business is:

Luis F. Gomez, Jr., Esq.

1500 S. Semoran Blvd.

Orlando, Florida 32807

THREE: The specific purposes for which this corporation is organized are as follows:

This corporation is organized for the purpose of advocating in favor of the permanence of marriage, and the rights of children to grow up in a loving, nurturing two-parent home, believing the only way to achieve this goal is that the home life of such a family be centered around the gospel of Jesus Christ. It will advocate in favor of reestablishing marriage as a sacred institution, fighting to make divorce unnecessary and rare, through Christian ministry and education. The corporation will also serve as an outreach and resource for churches of all denominations who wish to establish ministries within their own institutions towards these same ends. The organization shall also serve as a bridge-builder between Spanish-language ministries and churches, and the English-speaking Christian community in order to facilitate fellowship and communication between the two communities in line with the same goals of strengthening families.

In addition, this corporation is organized exclusively for one or more of the purposes as specified in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, including, for such purposes, the making of distributions to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding section of any future federal tax code.

FOUR: The number of initial directors of this corporations is to be three, and are to be elected as stated in the by laws of this organization.

FIVE: The name and address of the incorporator of this corporation is; Luis F. Gomez, Jr., 1500 S. Semoran Blvd., Orlando, Fl. 32807.

SIX: The period of duration of this corporation is perpetual.

SEVEN: The classes, rights, privileges, qualifications, and obligations of members of this corporation are as follows:

This corporation shall have one class of membership. Any person shall be qualified to become a member upon payment of the initial dues, if any, fixed by the board of directors and shall continue as a member upon paying the annual dues, if any, fixed by the board of directors. The method and time of payment of dues shall be determined, and may be changed, from time to time, by the board of directors. Additional provisions specifying the rights and obligations of members shall be contained in the Bylaws of this corporation pursuant to, and in accordance with, the laws of the State of Florida.

EIGHT: Any additional provisions for the operation of the corporation are as follows:

Upon the dissolution of this corporation, its assets remaining after payment, or provision for payment, of all debts and liabilities of this corporation shall be distributed for one or more exempt purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or shall be distributed to the federal government, or to a state or local government, for a public purpose. The first choice shall be the Centro de la Familia Cristiana, located at 4365 Kennedy Ave., Orlando, Florida, on condition that that church continues to retain its exempt status under IRS Section 501(c)(3) at the time of dissolution, should that occur.

No substantial part of the activities of this corporation shall consist of carrying on propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation (except as otherwise provided by Section 501(h) of the Internal Revenue Code), and this corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements), any political campaign on behalf of, or in opposition to, any candidate for public office.

No part of the net earnings of this corporation shall inuxe to the benefit of, or be distributable to, its members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that this corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles.

Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (1) by a corporation exempt from federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or (2) by a corporation contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code.

In any taxable year in which this corporation is a private foundation as described in Section 509(a) of the Internal Revenue Code, the corporation 1) shall distribute its income for said period at such time and manner as not to subject it to tax under Section 494? of the Internal Revenue Code; 2) shall not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941(d) of the Internal Revenue Code; 3) shall not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943(c) of the Internal Revenue Code; 4) shall not make any investments in such manner as to subject the corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Internal Revenue Code; and 5) shall not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945(d) of the Internal Revenue Code.
