ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE DANNY FOUNDATION, INC. a Florida Non-Profit Corporation

FILED
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ARTICLE I NAME OF CORPORATION

The name of this Corporation is THE DANNY FOUNDATION, INC.

ARTICLE II

CORPORATE NATURE

This is a non-profit Corporation, organized solely for general educational and charitable purposes pursuant to the Florida Corporations Not For Profit Law set forth in Section 617 of the Florida Statutes.

ARTICLE III

DURATION

The term of existence of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE IV

PURPOSE

This Corporation is organized exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes, including, for such purposes, the making of distribution to organizations that qualify as exempt organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code or corresponding section of any future federal tax code. The Corporation shall help to educate the general public about muscular dystrophy, obtain funds from private and public sources for the purpose of distribution to research organizations, charitable foundations, and families who have a child suffering from muscular dystrophy. The Corporation shall engage in various fundraising activities to achieve the above-mentioned purposes, including the application for and receipt of grants from State or Federal governmental authorities, public and private foundations, and individuals. The Corporation shall also engage in any lawful business or activities related thereto and engage in any other lawful act where activity for which corporations may be organized under the Florida Not For Profit Chapter.

ARTICLE V

DIRECTORS

There shall be three (3) members of the initial Board of Directors of the Corporation, and the initial Board of Directors shall adopt such criteria in its by-laws as it deems appropriate to

ARTICLE VI

ARTICLE VII

MEMBERS

Notwithstanding any other provisions of these Articles, the Corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) or future United States Internal Revenue Laws, or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 or any amendments or corresponding provisions of future United States Internal Revenue Laws.

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ARTICLE IX

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DISSOLUTION
