ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

ARTICLE I

SECTION OF STATE TALLAHASSEE, FLORIDA

The name of this Corporation is:

LILY OF THE VALLEY HUMANITARIAN ASSOCIATION, INC.

ARTICLE 11

DURATION

The term of existence of the Corporation is perpetual.

ARTICLE III

PUPOSE

The Corporation is organized not for profit, but for the purposes of being a humanitarian ministry. The general nature of the objects and purpose of the Corporation shall be:

- (a) To develop among his members the meaning and the benifit of working together in unity.
- (b) To assure protection to his members against cessation from work.
- (c) To promote and encourage all philantrophic program such as educational, social, moral, and material by working honestly together in the respect of the laws and the neighbor.
 - (d) To provide Day Care for children.
- (e) To preach and teach the Gospel of the Kingdom of God and the Lordship of Jesus Christ unto all nations as a witness to the Name, Word and Supremacy of Almighty God.
- (f) To conduct local and worldwide assemblies for the public worship of God and to publicly, as well as privately, preach and teach to those persons wiling to receive, the Gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ and his Kingdom.

- (g) To prepare, teach, train, financially support, maintain and send forth to various parts of the world, Christian workers and ministers for the propagation of the Gospel of the Kingdom of God and for the public and private Christain worship of God the Father and our Lord Jesus Christ as led by the Holy Spirit of God.
- (h) To teach and train qualified candidates for the ministry and to authorize, license and ordain ministers of the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ for foreign and home fields and to issue ministerial credentials such as licenses and certificates of ordination qualifying said ministers to perform sacerdotal functions, services and ministries.
- (i) To establish and maintain integrated auxiliaries such as private Bible schools, institutes, training centers, group, seminars, confrences, conventions and summer camps for instruction of men, women, and children in the Bible, Bible literature, Bible history and related subjects.
- (j) To provide and maintain homes, places and buildings for housing and training ministers, teachers, workers, and instructors of the Gospel of Jesus Christ and any other staff personnel.
- (j-I) To establish special centers for prevention and cure of drug addiction.
 - (j-11) To establish youth centers.
- (j-III) To establish social agencies to help find employment, help the refugees, teach various skills and perform other needed social work.
- (j-IV) To establish a special agency to help gather food, clothing, medicines, etc..., for the needy of other countries.

- (k) To print and distribute Bibles and disseminate Bible truths in various languages by means of making and publishing books, commentaries and literature containing information and comments explaining Bible truths and the establishment of the Kingdom of God under the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
 - (k-I) To establish a tape and record ministry.
- (1) To own, use or operate radio broadcasting stations, television and any other media for preaching the Gospel of the Kingdom under the Lordship of Jesus Christ.
- (1-1) To establish a consistent television and other media ministry in this country and abroad.
- (m) To finance the needs of this corporation through the receiving of donations, goods, merchandise and any and all other articles such as are necessary and through any lawful method deemed necessary by its Board of Directors and in conformity with its purpose.
- (n) To support foreign and home missionaries with prayer, services in kind and financial aid.
- (o) To acquire property, both real and personal, by purchase lease, gift, devise, bequest or otherwise and to hold, invest, use, lease, operate, improve, develop, sell, mortgage or otherwise encumber and in every waay control, manage and deal in personal property and real property, both improved and unimproved, for all appropriate corporate purposes.
- (p) To engage in any and all other activities which will directly or indirectly, not contrary to the corporation's non-pr profit status, improve the welfare and economic conditions of the membership and associate membership, including but not limited to food, clothing and other cooperative ventures, housing projects, participation in government programs compatible with

the corporation's purpose and to engage in activities regarding development of job training, employment, managerial opportunities and the membership and associate membership's fullest potential as disciples of the Lord Jesus Christ.

(q) To have all lawful powers incidental to corporations of its charecter, including, in perpetuity, all powers set forth in Chapter 617, "Corporations Not for Profit", <u>Florida Statutes</u> 617,021, or the corresponding provision of any future Florida Statutes as to same and amendment thereto.

ARTICLE IV

MEMBERSHIP

The qualification of members and the manner of their admission is as follows:

- (a) Membership is open to any person, without regard to race, age, sex or national origin who accepts and receives Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior and upon their own declaration, subject to a simple majority vote of the Board of Direct, and persuant to the Bylaws of the Corporation, desires to commit themselves to the Corporation's purposes as outlined in Article III herein. Members shall regularly support the work of LILY OF THE VALLEY HUMANITARIAN ASSOCIATION.
- (b) Membership in the Corporation shall terminate by death, resignation and removal for good cause, the latter instance requiring a two-thirds (2/3) majority vote of the Board of Directors.

ARTICLE V

POWERS

This Corporation shall have the power to acquire and hold title in fee simple, in trust, or otherwise, to both real and personal property, and to improve, encumber, sell, convey, and dispose of all such property, and to improve, encumber, sell, convey, and dispose of all such property, to borrow money execute notes, bonds and other evidences of indebtness and secure the same by mortgage and deeds of trust, annuity bonds and other instuments of indebtness and pay interest thereon; to improve, adapt and use its property or the income thereof in its religeous educational benevolent, or social activities, without financial profit to its members except as may be necessary in the payment of salaries or other compensation for services rendered: corporation shall have the power to erect and maintain buildings for the worship of God, for training in Christian faith and conduct, and for Christian social intercourse, and to acquire or build and maintain residences for the use occupancy of its ministers.

NON-PROFIT

The Corporation, being not for profit, shall have no shares of stock of any classification, nor shall any of same be issued. No dividend shall be paid and no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benifit of, or be distributable to its members, associate members, directors, officers, or other private persons, except that the Corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for the services rendered and to make payments and distribution

in furtherance of the purposes set forth in these Articles of Incorporation and its Bylaws.
