## ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

CHRISTIAN LIFE WORLD OF ALACHUA COUNTY, INC. (a Florida Corporation not for Profit)

# ARTICLE I

# **CORPORATE NAME**

The name of this corporation shall be the CHRISTIAN LIFE WORLD OF ALACHUA COUNTY, INC.

# **ARTICLE II**

## **CORPORATE NATURE**

This is a corporation not for profit, organized solely for religious, charitable, and educational purposes pusuant to the Florida Corporations Not for Profit Law set forth in Section 617 of the Florida Statutes.

# ARTICLE III

## **DURATION**

The term of existence of the corporation is perpetual and shall begin on July 16, 1996.

### ARTICLE IV

## **PURPOSES**

The specific and primary purposes for which this corporation is formed are:

1. For the advancement of religion, charity, education and any other related or corresponding charitable purposes by the distribution of its funds for such purposes.

- 3 To generally exercise all the rights and powers conferred by law for non profit corporations.
- 4. To do such other things as are incidental to the foregoing or necessary or desirable in order to accomplish the foregoing.
- 5. The Corporation shall operate exclusively in any other manner for such religious, charitable, and educational purposes as will qualify it as an exempt organization under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954, as amended, or under any corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax laws, covering the distributions to organizations qualified as tax exempt organizations under the Internal Revenue Code, as amended, including foundations and private operating foundations.

## ARTICLE V

#### MANAGEMENT OF CORPORATE AFFAIRS

Board of Directors. The Board of Elders shall have the rights and duties of directors as set forth in Chapter 607, Florida Statutes. The powers of this corporation shall be exercised, its properties controlled, and its affairs conducter by a Board of Directors, consisting of not less than three (3) persons. Initially, the number of Directors of the corporation shall be three, provided however that such number may be changed by the bylaws duly adopted by the members.

The Board of Directors named herein as the first Board of Directors shall hold office until the first meeting of members at which time an election of Directors shall be held. The Board of Directors shall be elected or appointed in accordance with the corporation's bylaws.

#### **ARTICLE VII**

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

The qualification for members and the manner of their admission shall be regulated by the bylaws for this corpuration.

# ARTICLE VIII

# EARNINGS AND ACTIVITIES OF THE CORPORATION

- A. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of, or be distributable to its members, directors, officers or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of the purposes set forth in Article IV above.
- B. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda, or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in, or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any candidate for public office.
- C. Notwithstanding any other provision of these articles, the corporation shall not carry on any other activities not permitted to be carried on (a) by a corporation exempt from Federal income tax under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Lav., or (b) by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law).
- D. Notwithstanding any other provision of these Articles, this corporation shall not, except to an insubstantial degree, engage in any activities or exercise any powers that are not in furtherance of the purposes of this corporation.

## ARTICLE IX

#### DISTRIBUTION OF ASSETS

Upon dissolution of the corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all the liabilities of the corporation,

dispose of all of the assets of the corporation exclusively for the purposes of the corporation in such manner, or to such organization or organizations organized and operated exclusively for charitable, educational, religious, or scientific purposes as shall at the time qualify as an exempt organization or organizations under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 (or corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law), as the Board of Directors shall determine. Any such assets not so disposed of shall be disposed of by a court of competent jurisdiction in the county in which the principal office of the corporation is then located, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations as such court shall determine, which are organized and operated exclusively for such purposes.
