ARTICLE I. Name

The specific purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

Shepherd Educational Services, Inc. shall be operated exclusively for charitable and/or educational purposes as described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, or corresponding provisions of any subsequent federal tax law, including, but not limited to the following particular purposes:

- a) To operate and maintain a school to provide education to children who are at academic risk, and
- b) To provide charitable grants and scholarships to facilitate access to educational services and programs for children who are at academic risk.

- c) This corporation shall not directly or indirectly participate or intervene in any political campaign on behalf or in opposition to any candidate for public office, including the publishing or distributing of statements; and
- d) The net earnings or assets of this corporation shall not inure in whole or in part to the benefit of private shareholders or individuals; and
- e) Shepherd Educational Services, Inc. and Shepherd Academy shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin in administration of its educational policies, admissions policies, scholarship and loan programs, and athletic or other school administered programs.
